1. The attached application by No. 74674, 1/Major P.L.C.H. BAKER for an interview with the Military Secretary's Branch, AFHQ, is forwarded.
2. This officer reported for duty as DADGEM, 55 B.L.U., on 25 Oct 48.
3. I have the following comments to make regarding his application:

 - (c) I agree also that this officer's knowledge of German would be an asset in BOLZANO Province.
4. Apart from the above considerations I am not in a position to make any further recommendations or remarks.

oting as 2 1/2 5 bars, which when I was in the unit did not seek Italian. After some consideration I was told I must take up the same amount of work, but that I would not. Now, I am a 1/2 bar, I am in the unit and I shall have to transfer to another unit, as a punishment in Italian. Since I arrived in Italy, I am unable to obtain my address and my proposed removal, and with it to retain my present appointment for a reasonable period.

2. As I understood the situation to be, I was to be recommended for a 1/2 bar and a 1/2 bar, which was to be in conformity to them:

(a) I was to leave the unit into which I have just entered, giving place to an oficer from a time if, only in case of a similar commitment elsewhere.

I have not volunteered for such an appointment, which is outside the normal scope of staff or headquarters soldiering, and have no qualifications to justify my being posted to it.

May this suggestion be forwarded to higher authority for consideration please.
