2. It has come to our knowledge that 362 Works Section RE Bologna have in store several refrigerators and that more are likely to become available as hospitals close down.
3. It is requested that authority be given for their issue to B.L.U.'s, and that this H.Q. be informed to whom indents should be forwarded.

1. Since this Unit is one of the very few that is likely to remain in Italy after all other Allied Units have left, it is requested that steps be taken, if possible, to instal a trombone heater in the Billets at the VILLA BIANCA, FALAZZO DUCALE, BOLZANO.

2. It is requested that a large electric refrigerator also be made available since this Unit is very short of transport and only draws rations from 200 miles away twice a week. This gives a lot of difficulty in preserving fresh items over a period. This of course will be even more difficult next summer.

3. If this is possible, 4 B.L.U. will ration and accommodate the personnel involved while they are working in this area.
