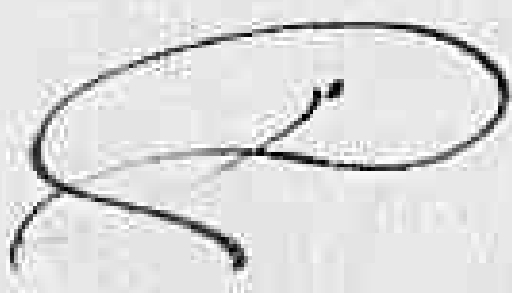

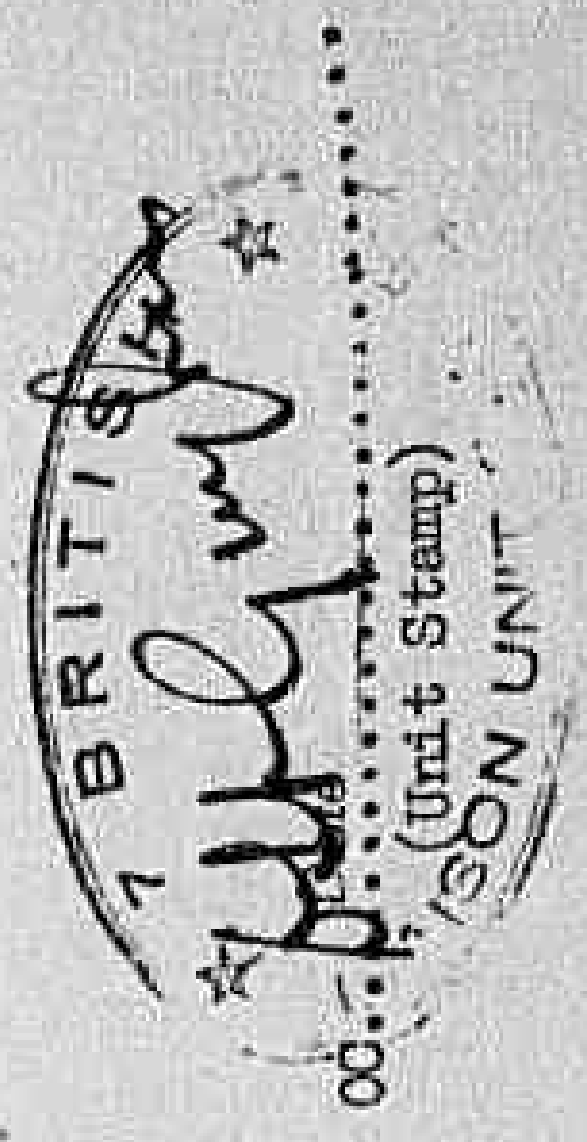

1. Ref. 020 464/46 and 217 Area letter 15/4 of 9 Jul 46.

2. I request the authority of your office to take 30 days privilege leave in lieu of two periods of 15 days, 15 Aug 46, and also to take 15 days in lieu of the normal 30 days privilege leave.

3. My special reasons are as follows:-

(a) On 1 Aug 46 I will have completed 7 months in GPO (North Italy) since my return from last tour on 1 Jan 46.

(b) I have been unable for military reasons to take my normal entitlement of 15 days privilege leave owing to the absence on comparative leave of my daughter. This absence is due to return on or about 4 Aug 46.

(c) If I am not granted only one period of 15 days privilege leave, plus 30 days privilege leave, I shall be ineligible on my return to take the normal period of 15 days privilege leave within the year 1 Jan 46 - 1 Jan 47. I am due for return on 10 Nov 47.

(d) If I am granted 30 days privilege leave plus 15 days privilege leave on 5 Aug 46, I will still have 4 months useful service on return, and before my date for return.

My letter 020/04/2113/2 of 25 Jan 46 has confirmed that I am eligible for two periods of 15 days privilege leave under the provisions of GPO, 1934/45 (as amended) and that the latest date of departure on such leave is 10 Aug 47, (which I require in view of my return to 10 Nov 47 under existing regulations). A certificate in accordance with para 7(e)(2) of the above quoted GPO 1934/45 is attached.

5. This is application for privilege leave and 15 Aug 46, and my special request for the full period of 30 days privilege leave, has been approved by Mr. J. H. Hester ref. 15/4 of 25 July 46. He has provided that I shall have period over my return to my daughter on his return.

6. In order that I may be able to obtain the necessary money for leave travel and to make the other necessary arrangements for my daughter, I

 - (2) If I am granted 30 days privilege leave plus 14 days 1 Jul'46 on 5 Aug'46, I will still have a further useful service on my return, and before my date for return.

4. (The letter 021/22/46 of 25 Jan'46 has confirmed that I am entitled to the latter date of departure under the provisions of GPO 1352/45 (an amended) is now changed to 10 Feb'47 under existing regulations).
A certificate in accordance with para 7(a)(2) of the above quoted GPO 1352/45 is attached.

5. This my application for privilege leave and return, and my special request for the full period of 30 days privilege leave, has been approved by H. J. J. (Letter ref. A. 338 of 25 Jan'46) with the provision that I shall have handed over my duties to my daughter on his return.

6. In order that I may be able to obtain the necessary money for leave travel and to make the other necessary arrangements for my departure, it is requested that this my application be given the earliest consideration and a decision be communicated to me by the earliest possible means.

1. Under the latest Regulations for Privilege Leave from C.M.F. this HQ. being within 217 Area, is considered as N. ITALY.
2. I am therefore eligible for Privilege Leave of 19 days w.e.f. 1 May 46 (i.e. 4 months after the termination of my last leave -JAP)
3. Major GREGSON (DAA & QEF), at present on 28 days compassionate leave in U.K. is due to return to this unit during the first week in Aug'46.
4. In order to allow for a period of approx. one week during which Major GREGSON and myself will be present with this Unit after his return from leave, may authority please be granted now for my departure on leave to U.K. on or after 15 Aug.'46 (depending on the date on which Major GREGSON rejoins the Unit).
5. In addition to the above 19 days Privilege Leave I would also ask authority to take my 28 days SEWIDOM in U.K. (G.R.O. 1352 of 21 Dec. 45 refers). G.H.Q. letter O2E/RQ/M 2118/P dated 25 Jan'46 has confirmed my eligibility for this End of War Leave.
6. Attached at App. A is copy of HQ. 217 Area letter A. 1301 of 9 July 46.
 It is not understood what type of "exceptional circumstances" are called for in order to obtain 38 days Privilege plus 14 days End of War Leave. I am due for PTEON in Feb.46, in which case I should be ineligible, after return in Oct'46 from 19 plus 28 days leave, for the second period of 19 days before returning home. In which case it would appear to suit me best to take the full 38 days privilege leave, plus 14 days SEWIDOM, thereby leaving over the balance of 14 days SEWIDOM to be taken on return to U.K. on PTEON.

It would be greatly appreciated if this latter question could be clarified by your HQ.

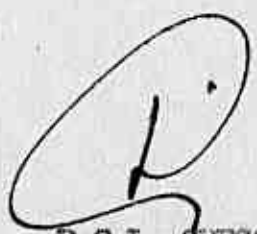
