Subject : Public RelationsTo : 7 Territorial Command (By hon. of Lieut BROWNING)

1. Information has been received from H.Q. M.I.A. that the Ministry of War have set up a Public Relations organisation.
Col. FIGUE → VIGHAZI has been appointed Director of P.R.
2. A copy of the letter and memorandum addressed to the Minister of War by H.Q. M.I.A. is enclosed.
3. Genl. BROWNING feels that the project is an important one and that when the P.R. office is set up and functioning, the Italian Army and nation will soon benefit materially.
4. Col. FIGUE → VIGHAZI understands the object of his task thoroughly; he will however require the cooperation and active assistance of Territorial Divisional and Regimental Commanders.
5. You will see from para 7 (a) of the memorandum that a P.R. Officer at each Territorial HQ. is envisaged. In this connection you are requested to forward your views as to whether you favour appointing an officer already on your staff to carry out the duties of P.R. officer in addition to his other duties or whether you favour the appointment of a whole time P.R. officer.
The Territorial Commander obviously is responsible for P.R. matters within his Command subject to War Ministry policy and direction, his P.R. officer would therefore only correspond with the Director P.R. on technical matters.
6. Any recommendations or suggestions you may have on the project would be welcomed by this HQ.
7. Any points of interest or action taken in this connection should be forwarded fortnightly so as to reach this HQ. on the 15th and last day of each month.
8. A very early reply is requested to paras 5 and 6.
