Subject : CC.RR. Mobile Bn. Florence.
To : M.M.I.A. Rome (Attention CC.RR. Sect.)
From : 7 B.L.U. Florence.

1. Attached is Daily State showing strength of Florence Mob. Bn. as on 25 Feb. 46, also location statement of personnel on detached duty.
2. Present strength of 193 officers and men, majority of whom are engaged on essential duties within the barracks, leaves only a very limited number available for emergency duties in connection with preservation of law and order.
3. Officers of the Bn. reside with their respective families in Florence and are not in telephonic communication with the barracks. This is due to barracks being occupied by the Mob. Bn. and the 7th Infantry Regt. The presence of the latter has also made necessary the employment of extra CC.RR. guards within the barracks. An unsatisfactory situation.
4. Efforts are being made to find other suitable accommodation for the Infantry Regt and release all barracks accommodation for use of Mob. Bn. and Special Coy CC.RR.
5. Personnel on special duty at Pisa, Sicily and Pistoia, (total 209 officers and men) were sent on instructions from CC.RR. General Command. Those at Pisa have been there since 9th Dec. 1945 and have had no training with their Bn. since then.
6. In its present reduced condition the Florence Bn. cannot be considered as a very effective striking force and the facts are submitted for whatever action may be considered necessary.
