To ; 7 Territorial Command.

1. This memorandum is forwarded in respect of the points raised and agreed at the interview between General De SIMONE and Majors GREGSON and GREENHOUGH on 27 April '46.
 - (a) Major GREGSON informed General De SIMONE that HQ., MIA had received information from the Min of War, that CASCINE barracks would not be allocated to 7 T.C.
 - (b) It was agreed that BALDISSERA barracks would be vacated by 7th Ind. Regt, and the whole of these barracks would be handed over to the CCRR.
 - (c) That the approximate date of the hand-over would be 5 May.
