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1. On 5 March 1946 Leghorn Legion received 500 pairs of re-conditioned boots from Naples, and on 30 March 1946 a further 898 pairs from Bari.
 2. Of these two consignments only 185 pairs were in fit condition to be issued immediately, the remainder requiring further repairs.

1. No request has ever been made by Florence or Bologna Legions for 50 quintals of leather.
2. The original request was for authority to transfer five (5) quintals of leather from Florence to Bologna to effect urgent repairs to boots (Hq. 3rd Bde letter 353/5/1945 of 18 Jan 46 to CGRM. General Command Hq. refers).
3. No authority was ever received from Rome and the leather has now been used by Florence Legion.
4. It is regretted that so much time has been taken up on this simple matter, but it is desired to point out that the information given from this Hq. is as reported in this letter and no reference was ever made regarding such quantity as 50 quintals of leather.
