Subject : Recovery of Italian Army Vehicles.

To : 7th Terr. Hq. (Attn: Chief of Staff).-

1. I wish to repeat once more the M.M.I.A. policy governing the return of Italian Army vehicles to the Italian Army.

A vigorous program must be maintained constantly so that all Italian Army vehicles are returned to Army control without delay.

M.M.I.A. will not countenance any evasion or laxity on this matter. Specifically, Italian Army vehicles in the hands of Prefecture are not exempt from recovery until 31 October 1945. Contrary orders from any source, including the Ministry of War, are to be disregarded, and reported to this office.

2. Please confirm that the above policy is understood, and will be complied with, by all units of the Territorial Command concerned with the recovery of vehicles. ✓
