A vigorous program must be maintained constantly so that all Italian Army vehicles are returned to Army control without delay. M.H.J.A. will not countenance any evasion or laxity on this matter. Specifically, Italian Army vehicles in the hands of Prefetture are not exempt from recovery until 31 October 1945. Contrary orders from any source, including the Ministry of War, are to be disgregated, and reported to this office.
