1. In accordance with the instructions received via your letter of 10 Oct 45 the attached "REPORT OF INVESTIGATION" is forwarded.

2. The apparent discrepancy in the report is explained by the E/M of this station in the following manner:

When the loss was discovered, the men decided to let the newcomers (T/5s Kilper and Peterson) report the theft to the MPs as Cpl Peckinpaugh and Pfc Doucet had to go to the office and do their work. This was done and the MPs made their investigation which produced nothing. Later in the day it was discovered that the loss of clothing sustained by Cpl Peckinpaugh and Pfc Doucet had not been reported. In view of the fact that the investigation had produced no results, the men decided against reporting the additional loss. However, when I went after the report, they decided to report it. As you will notice on the MPs report, this clothing was not reported till the 15 Oct 45.

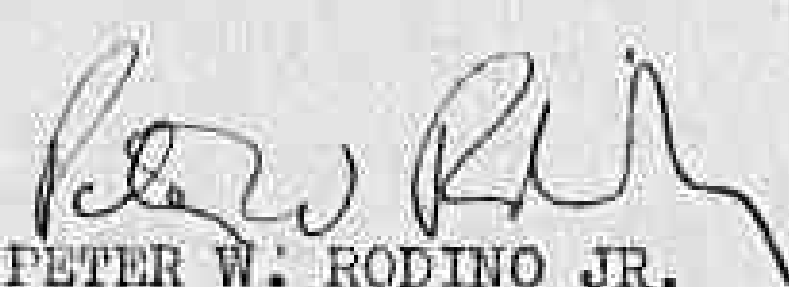

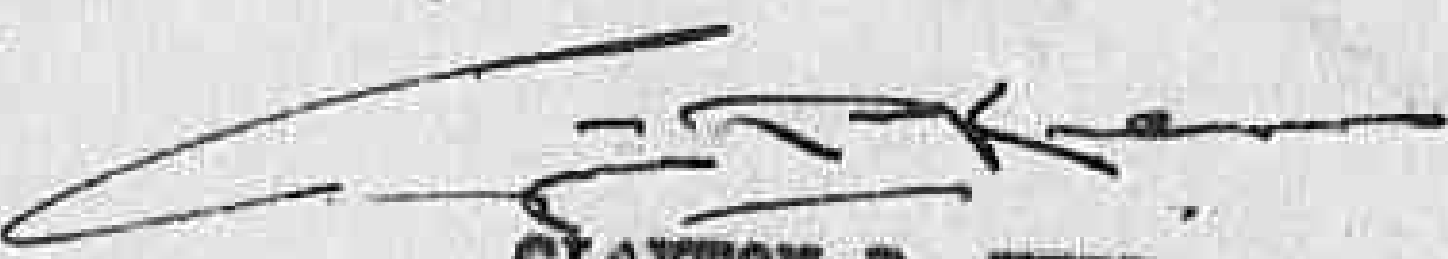

1. Capt Leverett C. Hamilton, 0410463, Inf, is hereby designated as "Soldier Voting Officer" for Bari Branch, 2691 MMIA Company (Ovhd) for the purpose of handling all administration pertaining to the execution of "State Absentee Ballots" during 1945.
2. Attached hereto are five (5) "USWBC Form No. 1" (Post Card Applications for State Absentee Ballots) to be used by either officers or enlisted men of your station who are desirous of voting.
3. The reverse side of USWBC Form No. 1 must be completed and the Form sent to the Secretary of State at the State Capitol of his state of voting residence.
4. It will not be necessary for soldier voting officer to keep a record of the number of USWBC Form No 1 used by personnel of his station.
5. The directions contained in each state ballot are different therefore each soldier voting must read carefully the instructions contained in his own state ballot. In most states Warrant Officers and non-commissioned officers can attest oath, whereas in some states only commissioned officers are eligible. No non-commissioned officer of technician grade can attest oath.
6. Ballots must not be censored.
7. Ballots do not require postage.
8. At various intervals this headquarters will forward to each soldier voting officer a list of the elections to be held in the various states and municipalities together with dates on which elections will take place.

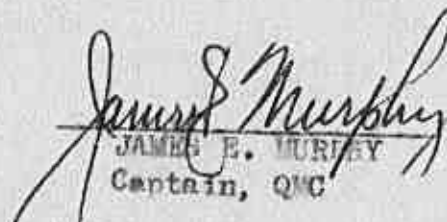

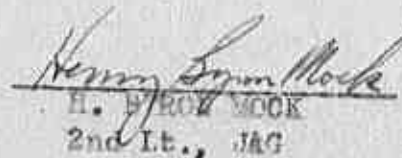
