I wish to stress the importance of acquiring the Caserma S Pasquale, Peri, for the C.A.R.

With the barracks at present available (Caserma Falanga e Milano) the number of men that will have to occupy each barrack room is 48.

This can be done by using two - tier bunks with spacing of about 6 inches.

Such a measure is not desirable with recruits for obvious reasons, and the acquisition of additional accommodation is necessary.

Since my Periodical Report No 1 was submitted, 4 Med Regt were moved out of Caserma S Pasquale, which HQ MILIA applied for on the 27th Dec from 3 District. Within the last week, however, 2 Cos of R.E. and 1 Coy RASC have been allocated to the Caserma, so it appears that 54 Area do not intend to let it go.

It is requested that representation is again made to 3 Dist, urging the importance of Caserma S Pasquale for the accommodation of recruits.
