1. Reference your No. 10119 dated 4 March 1945.
2. MMIA LO Bari advises us that CCRR demanded an issue of 132 pairs of boots in exchange for old boots, in accordance with authority granted by you under the above reference letter.
3. The 5,500 pairs of boots released to the Carabinieri, in exchange for an equal number of repairable boots which they are to return, have already been withdrawn from Italian Depot at Naples. There is, therefore, no authority against which issues like the one requested can be made.
4. The granting of a further allotment of boots to the Carabinieri, in exchange for boots to be repaired, will be considered when it has been determined that they have actually returned the old boots as required under the provisions of the original allotment.
5. In the meantime, will you please cancel the Issue Order No. 10119 dated 4 March, and any similar Issue Order that may be affected.

Reference your AQ/15 dated 8 Jan. '45, subject "Boots for CCRR", and AQ/15/1 dated 15 March '45, subject "Boots Due CCRR Under Allotments".

1. Herewith is copy of letter from the Ministry of War (prot. N; 16119 dated 4/3/45) to Centro Regionale Recupero in which the issue of 132 pr. of boots is authorized for 132 pr. of boots turned in for repair.
2. The M/W authorization seems to be a bit out of line for two reasons. (a) It does not agree with the policy as outlined in your AQ/15 of 8 Jan. (b) Centro Regionale Recupero is not an issuing agency.
3. It is the understanding of this office that the 5500 pr. of boots released under AQ/45/IRI/13 of 8 Jan. were for replacement purposes, and when the CCRR has turned in an equivalent amount for repair, another allotment will be made to CCRR. Your AQ/15/1 of 15 March cancels AQ/45/IRI/13 as far as Bari depots are concerned, as the boots have already been collected from Naples depot.
4. Any efforts that can be exerted to put the CCRR on the right track will be appreciated, as the frequent and persistent efforts of the local CCRR to obtain clothing and boots, by hook or by crook, from Bari depots is getting monotonous.

It would appear that the CCRR are not fully aware of the fact the special allotment was made, to be drawn from Naples Depot, to equip the various units of the Pecina Division, and that the M/W was responsible to have this allotment distributed to various points for the Battalions of the Peciro Div., or are attempting to obtain additional clothing under false pretenses. Since the clothing was not made available at the points designated in time to clothed the Battalions upon arrival, it was necessary to make issue from La Rocca Depot. These issues were deducted from the CCRR allotment which remained in La Rocca Depot. The CCRR is now asking for a replacement on those issues.
3. The local CCRR has been advised that they must make their own stock adjustment. It is requested that this matter be taken up and clarified with Comando General Dell 'Arma Dei Carabinieri Reali.
