PRO-MEMORIATRANSLATIONMILITARY MATERIAL OUT OF USE

A circular of 23/11/44 of the Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Work established the opportunity that all the Military Material which is no more used by military administrations would be passed on to the Workers' Organisations in order to be employed by the same workers.

While negotiations to this end were carried out with the Direction of Bari Military Commissariat, for the purchase of q/11 2000 of used shoes stored in Via Re David di Bari, the Military Commissariat informed us that the above said material could not be delivered to us owing to dispositions of the Land Force Sub-Commission A.C. (M.M.I.A.) which intended to take it for its own necessity.

Same communication was confirmed by the Ministry of war with note n°15536/VC of 17/4/45.

In spite of our many requests to M.M.I.A. it is not yet been possible to get those shoes unblocked and meanwhile they are kept in an open space, exposed to all the inclemencies of the weather.

Di tanto dava conferma il Ministero della Guerra con nota n.15536/VC del 17/4/1945.

Malgrado l'interessamento esplicato presso la locale M.M.I.A., non si è potuto ancora ottenere lo sblocco delle scarpe in parola, le quali, malamente ammassate ed esposte ad intemperie, vanno soggette a furti e ad ulteriori deterioramenti.
