A return will be rendered by each co-operator Unit to DDOS of Districts, showing holdings of vehicles and equipment in excess of British Cadre entitlements as at 30 Jun 45. It will be the responsibility of DDOS District to maintain these lists.

When the return of the equipment is ordered, it will be checked under arrangements of DDOS District who will prepare a consolidated deficiency list of the difference between issues and receipts. A voucher will be prepared showing these differences and an acknowledged copy obtained from MMIA who will debit the cost to the Italian Government".

With ref. and further to letter no 6330 Ben. of 5 Jun 45, which referred to the situation existing in the Soldiers Institutes at Taranto, Lecce and Trani.

For the Soldiers' Institute at Taranto, this H.Q. has requested from the M. of War - D.G.S.C.A. - the necessary stores, both for the furnishing of the Institute and its functioning.

Regarding the stores for furnishing, the Ministry has already given orders for their drawing from the ~~S.S. of the~~ Commissariat, ^{Detachment} at Catanzaro. However, ^{regarding} for the kitchen utensils and other stores necessary to the functioning of the Institute, the Ministry has sent to this H.Q. a letter, copy of which attached, from which we gather that ~~the~~ the request made to the M.M.I.A. has not met with any success, as it deals with ~~unfurnished~~ ^{disposal} stores at the ~~order~~ of the Allies.

Since there is no other way possible of providing, and the Soldiers' Institute remains thus ^{affected} ~~affected~~, we

we consider it opportune to present our case to your office, to ascertain whether it would be possible to obtain from the M.M.I.A. the ^{release of} ~~permission to draw~~ the stores detailed on the ~~xxxx~~ attached sheet.
