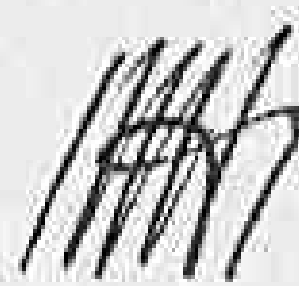

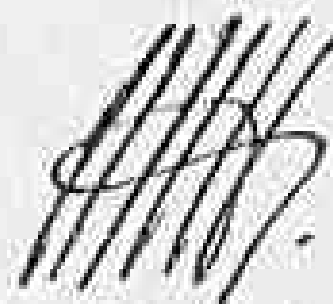

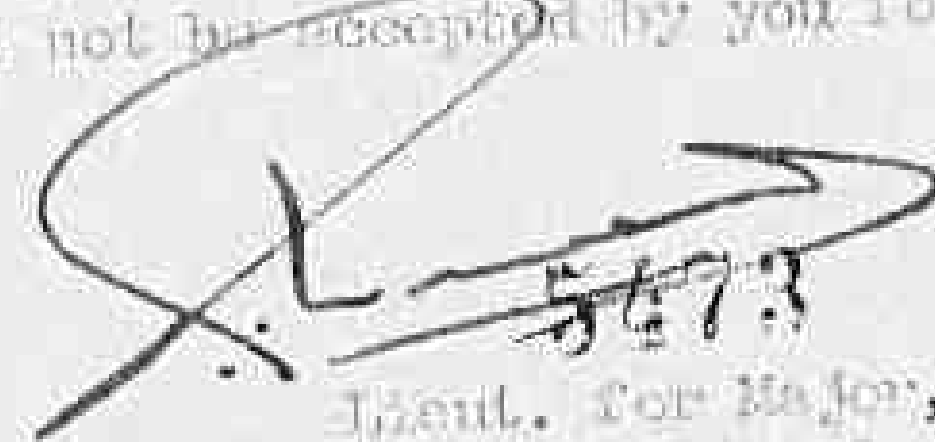

1. I have today spoken to MIA (Major Hubbard) and he informs me that although he understands that the policy is for all issue clothing, including boots and battle-dress, to be handed over unwashed, un-repaired and un-dyed, so far he has not received firm instructions from his H.Q.
2. He also said that the battle-dress now being dyed by Bernard under L.P. & P. contract is not acceptable by MIA as the colour is far too dark - almost black. This contract is now being held up pending final decision, but it would appear that in view of the new policy that it would be preferable for MIA to make their own dyeing arrangements, especially as they have supplies of the proper colour dye (Spruce Green).
3. Your further instructions are awaited.

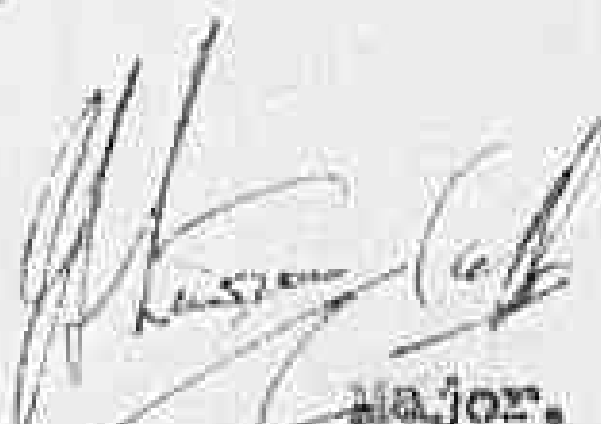

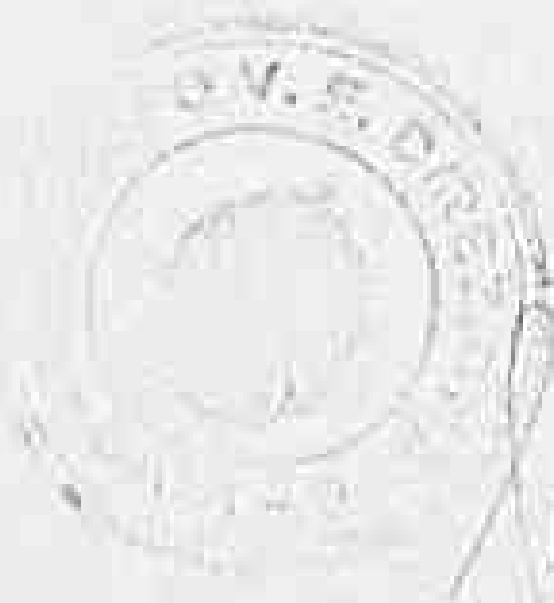

2. The instructions in AFHQ Administrative Memorandum Number 5 direct the shipments to certain British Ordnance Depots of accumulations in Peninsular Base Section of unserviceable shoes and clothing which are in such condition as to be beyond economical repair for further use by the United States Army including prisoners of war. Unserviceable clothing and shoes are therefore, to be removed from salvage to be sold in accordance with authority contained in the letter referred to in par. 1, above.

3. In view of the apparent need for this clothing, it is requested that the necessary arrangements be made with British Ordnance Depots and that shipments thereof be expedited.

4. The transfers are to be accomplished by means of signed and priced shipping tickets, and are to be included in the "Monthly Summary Report of Supplies and Subsistence Furnished", made to the Chief Accountant, Allied Military Government.

5. The value of the material to be transferred in accordance with this authority will depend on its condition at the time of shipment. Authority is granted to fix fair estimated prices for the various items. It is thought that as a general rule, a fair valuation will not exceed 25% of the original cost of new articles as listed in AR 30-3000.

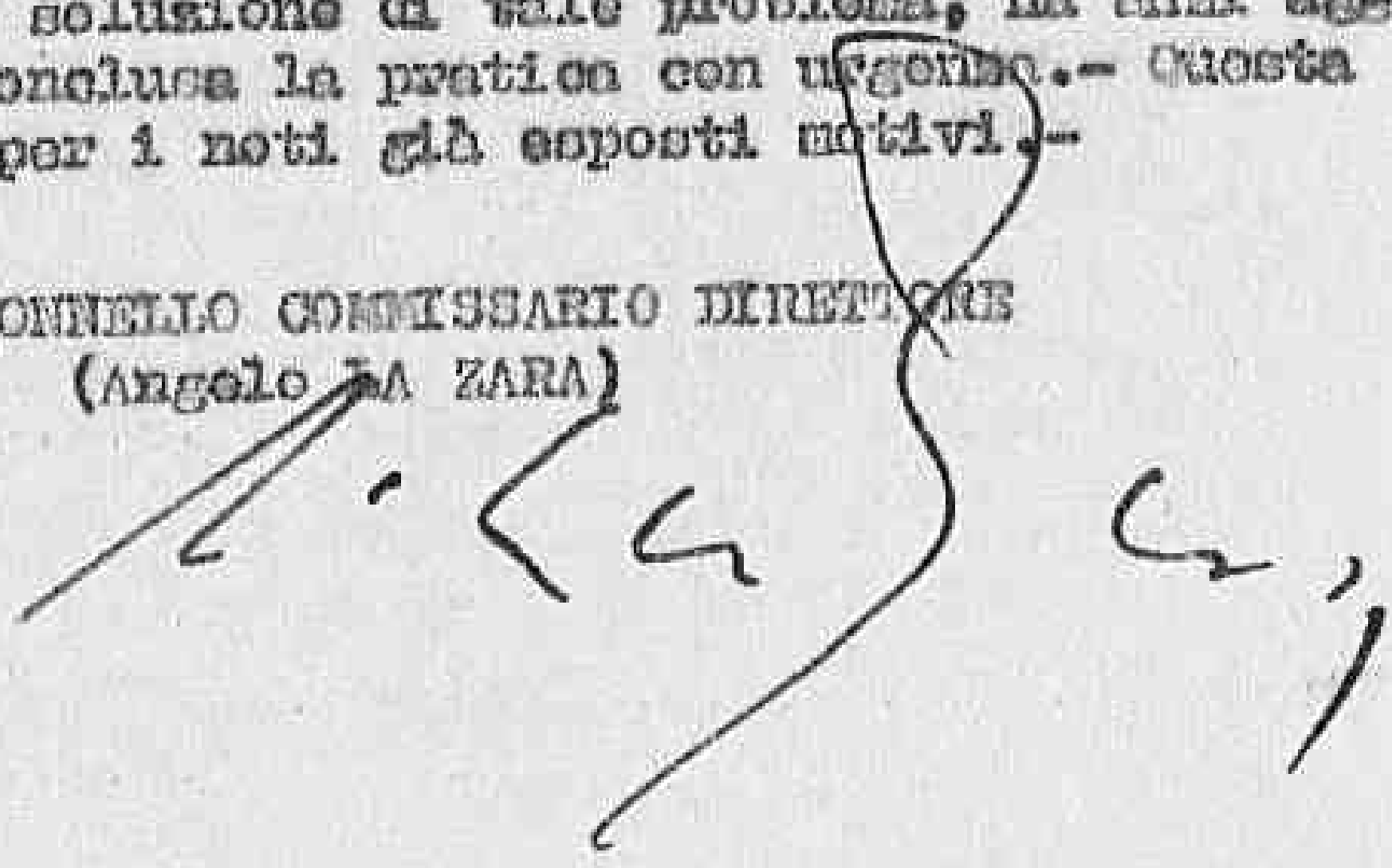
