Such an allowance was according the strength who belonged to this Company at that time but until now the necessities have steadily risen for men of 323 Company were sent to this Head quarter or wear and tear. It is justified the raincoats' request because the men must work on the line at any time, supposing that the soldiers have only one uniform for each one and therefore they could not continue the work in the case of rain or snow. It is justified the demand of field blankets for the soldiers and the blankets for the officers because the majority of squads are placed in billets which are not in good conditions. It is absolutely necessary and urgent the demand for winter-clothings be requested.

STORMS: As it is followed by the connected show (n° 2) the squads are short of several stores among more necessary and indispensable. We ask that such a stores are allotted as soon as possible.

VEHICLES:

The precarious situation of vehicles is clear by the followed show (n° 3). Such a situation is caused; supposing that the vehicles which have been given were already in bed condition and on ~~other~~ the other side the available drivers were mediocre. The position has particularly become worse because many difficulties arise every time the vehicles must be repaired, even in the result is not a hard job. In every case the vehicle which was taken to workshop was sent back after ten days or a fortnight, some other after more months, supposing that the number of the vehicles given on our charge for each one section are hardly sufficient for the work, even if only one truck is out of order some men cannot continue the work. It is followed by the show (n° 3) that 41 vehicles are short of water proof and superstructure and lights. Under such conditions it will be very difficult to ensure the maintenance when the weather is bad and during the night time. We recall head quarter's attention to whom this letter is forwarded on these deficiencies.

This head quarter explains that if all the deficiencies above mentioned have been fronted until now during the spring time, it will be very difficult or quite impossible to front the same deficiencies during the winter season. 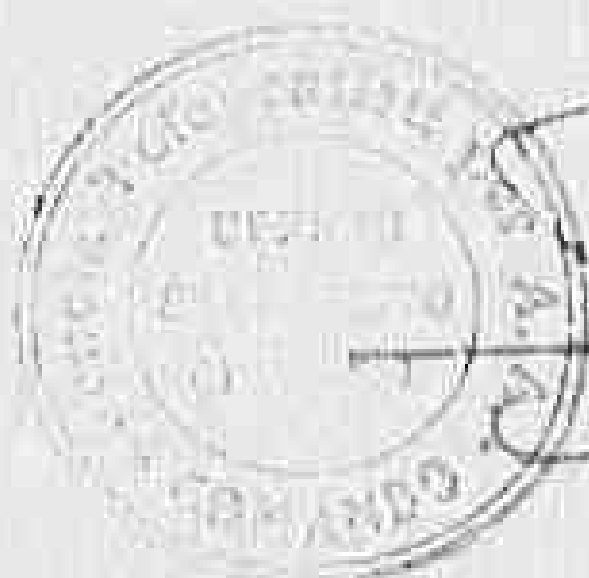

1. The 320/I Coy, consisting of 4 Signal Operator Sections, is considered a Unit at the order of 2 Signal Corps. The official sanction of the formation, of the H.Q. based on the new War Establishment has not yet been given. Also, the new denomination has not been given and this is necessary because the denomination of "320/I Coy" is conventional as this unit was officially disbanded on Aug. the 1st.

2. -Clothing and Equipment-

This H.Q. finds it difficult to renew periodically clothing and equipment which have worn out. Therefore many soldiers are not fit to continue their duty of maintaining the military telephone lines.

In order to avoid inconveniences and discrepancies this H.Q. should be allowed to put in a request every 15 days or every month for such renewals and the requests should be authorized immediately. In this manner the line-men would be able to perform their duty efficiently.

3. Exceptional requests: To whom should they be made and which is the procedure? - Example: - A large number of squads operate in malarious areas without any chemical or mechanical protection. I have often reported such conditions without obtaining any result and the unit has and has had many malaric casualties.

The unit has no hygienic facilities such as: soap, razor blades, toothpaste, toothbrushes, etc.- Is it possible to draw periodically such articles even paying for them?

4. 30 line-men are needed for the formation of the 504 Section and in order of have a large number of reserve personnel, and it is requested that these men be assigned from the 2 Course that is being held for line-men at Francavilla Fontana.
