It is requested that the Italian personnel of this Unit be authorised to draw rations on the Combat Scale in view of the heavy manual labour which the work of a Forestry Coy. entails.

The principle that Forestry Companies should be allowed extra rations was recognised by A.C.I. of 194, which introduced an increased scale of rations for British and Dominion Forestry Companies. The Italians of this Unit are doing work identical with that performed by members of British and Dominion Coys., and it is contended that the Basic Scale plus 2 ozs P. Meat which they are receiving now is insufficient.

It would be appreciated if this could be regarded as a special case for consideration by higher authority.

1. A request has been received from 'A' Transit Veh Pk of "E" Veh Coy for authority to issue daily up to 70 British Transit ~~ration~~ rations to Italian military personnel.
2. A company of 100 men and 1 officer from 9th Regt Artieri, Bari are attached to this unit for driving duties under instructions from H.M.I.A. Of this number approximately 70 are employed on long distance convoy work; the remainder being employed locally and are thus able to be fed on the normal Italian ration.
3. The Italian ration is quite unsuitable for making into a "haversack ration" for a meal on the roadside. As a result the men concerned are having to go without food from 0700 till 1900 hrs. The unit state that this is affecting their stamina and general health, resulting in reduced efficiency.
4. This HQ supports the request which is forwarded for your consideration, but suggests that the issue might be on a scale of one ration to two men.
