FREELAND'S efforts whilst in ROME, but as it was admitted immediately prior to his visit that no official demand for CLOTHING had been made by you, it is understandable that you cannot clothe CORVAGLIA PANTALEO. Please inform this office forthwith what action, if any, has been taken to improve the morale of troops located at your PETROL DEPOTS who are utterly dejected due to neglect.

Siete tutti giovani, robusti e forti tra i 20 e 30 anni, alcuni anche più giovani ancora in pieno sviluppo fisico. Ci troviamo qui, bloccati, in un ospedale paese delle Puglie, col 235 reggimento fanteria, perché le nostre case ancora non sono state liberate e a quanto si sente dire spetta anche a noi avviarci verso il fronte al quale andremo tutti con buona volontà, per fare più presto a liberare l'Italia.

Ma ci è un mal! Un mal grande e grosso come l'Imelaia che la saggezza e di l'Potere che lor Signori hanno può far rimpicciolire tanto da potersi scavalcare con un passo o meglio ancora eliminare totalmente con un semplice soffio di prestigiatore. Presso questo reggimento non è sta mae; vi sono ufficiali buoni e capaci, quasi tutti meritevoli di rispetto, la maggior parte con tendenze a farsi notare dai loro diretti superiori, specialmente quando si avvicina l'epoca delle promozioni, la metà di essi di stile ancora prettamente fascista che ancora oggi vorrebbe ostentare sulle loro sgargianti divise i segni meritorî ottenuti col decaduto regime, ma enormemente egoisti che pensano solo per loro, senza il minimo interessamento per noi.

Noi che, privati del tanto caro vaglia che soleva giungere più o meno regolarmente, dalle nostre famiglie, ogni mese, dobbiamo adattarci a quella irrisoria "de-cede", la quale non è sufficiente a compensare le spese del nostro ben noto vizio del fumare e trascurare totalmente la cura del nostro fisico privandolo di altri alimentiche ci abbisognano. Il perché di questo sta nel fatto che la stagione autunnale volge alla sua fine e per la campagna i frutti si sono rarefatti. Fio oggi la regionevole compassione e bontà dei coloni ci aiutava nel donarci, senza parsimonia tutto quello che poteva offrire la loro terra ma ora che i frutteti sono spogli e l'uva è stata pigiata, anche nelle botteghe non si trova più niente. La ragione di vivere oggi il comando ha stabilito è sufficiente, al nostro fisico, per un pasto solo e cioè quello di mezzogiorno. E alla sera? E al mattino? Il semplice "caffè" del mattino ancora colorato che lo pigliano: questi si vede che hanno "arrangiato" un pezzo di pane da inzupparvelo. Come fare per poter saziare la nostra fame dalla sera alle 17 alle 12 del giorno appresso? dopo aver mangiato 28 grammi di formaggio, 84 di carne in scatola, un poco di pane avanzato alle 12 del minestrone, ed un pugno di mandorle secche, sozze, luride, im-

piastriate di terriccio, il 40% selvatiche, cioè amaregnole, il 30% fetide, puzzolenti, tarlate, guaste e non parliamo del vino, benché sempre lo diluiscano con altrettanto di acqua è sempre fortemente acidolo. Se lo si lascia per due ore nel gavettino si decompone lasciando al fondo una spessa patina di tartaro e metabisolfito. Per procurarci altro cibo dobbiamo ancora ricorrere al ben noto sistema della vendita degli oggetti di corredo sottratti al compagno? Ci è penoso quanto scorretto rendere edotti a Voi portatori di benessere in Italia, quanto sopra, ma è un problema oltremodo interessante, che spetta esclusivamente a voi la soluzione dato che i nostri superiori ad una preghiera di tal genere non danno altro che l'evasiva risposta della solita scollata tina di spalle, manifesto segno di non poter far niente, perché loro ben satolli ad ogni pasto, fatto di un bi-primo, un secondo, frutta e caffè, capaci di appagare di sovente i loro istinti, i quali, che lo stipendio da essi percepito offre la possibilità di soddisfare quasi al capriccio, se ne infischiano del modo con cui i dipendenti possono vivere. Ben immaginiamo di quale portata sono le svariate richieste che vi pervengono da tutte le parti ma siamo anche certi e ne nutriamo la massima fiducia, del Vostro interessamento verso questa nostra supplica che riveste carattere di una certa importanza ai fini dello sforzo comune che anche questo reparto dovrà portare in un prossimo avvenire, onde a battere completamente l'attuale nostro nemico.

Se ci aiutate a far sì che il nostro fisico possa rispondere a quanto gli viene richiesto di fare, saremo pronti tutti a qualsiasi cimento altrimenti dovremmo giacere all'inevitabile abbattimento di rilassatezza che già si è incominciata a manifestare tra di noi, causata dalla deficiente nutrizione oltreché dall'accasciamento morale per tutti i disagi cui siamo sottoposti benché non ve ne sia nessuna ragione. Venite a farci una visita e constaterete voi "de visu" se quanto sopra è corrispondente a verità.

Several young men, accomplishing their military service in the 235-th Infantry Regiment, garrisoned in Locorotondo (Pa. lie), because their homes are not yet liberated and being trained to go to the battle front as soon, as possible, beg to draw the attention of the hon. A.C.C. on certain abuses within this regiment.

There are in this regiment still numerous Officers, pervaded with fascist spirit, who would like to wear on their brilliant uniforms, the distinctions, received during the fallen regime. Though having some capacities and not without merits, they are servile towards their superiors, and egoists towards the inferiors. They do not care for the physical health of their soldiers.

The pay of the soldiers being insufficient, and getting no remittances from their homes, they are not able to buy the most necessary articles. As they have only one meal per day of inferior quality, they are exposed to hunger.

The Officers do not show any interest to improve these evils, though they are in a much better position, having abundant meals and payments, which is sufficient to satisfy all their caprices.

The above said soldiers request the hon. A.C.C. to inquire into these abuses, and to help, if possible to eliminate them.

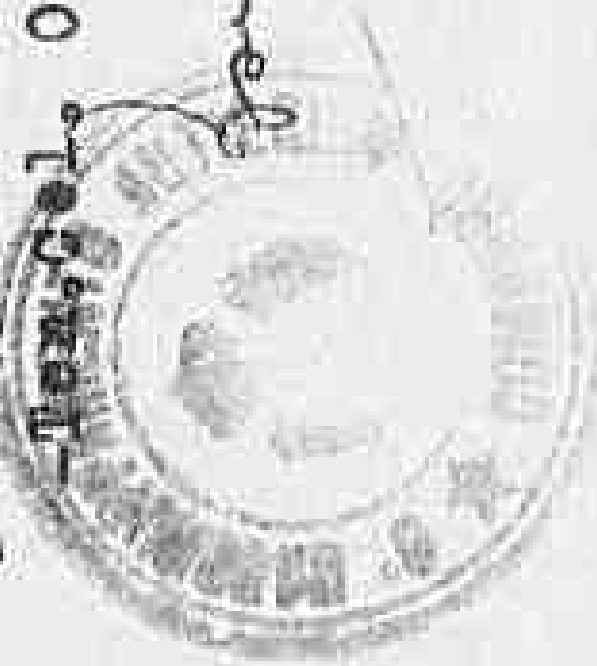

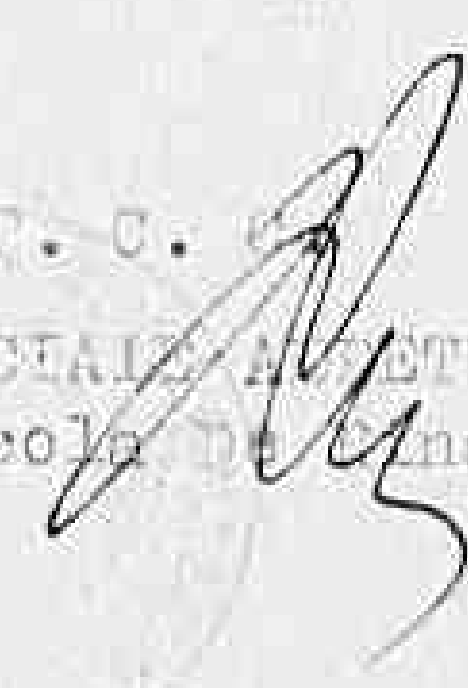

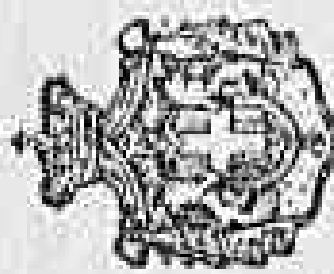

" The Italian personnel of this Unit are Co-Belligerents posted within the UE of the Unit. The Italian Officer is himself on the posted strength of the Unit, shown in the UE as in the HQ Platoon. As such he is, or should be, subject in all matters to the orders of the CC Unit, and should conform to British Military law and customs.

Recent misunderstandings tend to show that the Italian Officer considers that he has an independent command, and that, e.g. he himself is at liberty to be absent at his own discretion without permission of the CC Unit. Being absent the other day for over five hours, the Italian Officer on being asked for an explanation stated in writing that 'in conformity with the regulations of the Italian Army an officer can leave his place (of duty?) for a period of a few hours without a special permission of his superiors.'

It is requested that you obtain from the IMTA a ruling that the Italian Officer of the Unit be subject in all matters to the authority of the CC Unit.
