The Italian Military personnel on attached sheetlets have for many months, and are at present working for U.S. Forces as indicated. It has been suggested by me for some time that as they were now highly trained specialized personnel, they should be transferred to the U.S. Italian allotment. This has been the subject of some correspondence and several conversations between myself and MIA.

During my last visit to MIA, it was arranged with Lt. Col. LAMBERT of MIA that this transfer would be effected subject to vacancies existing on the U.S. allotment. The matter is now in the hands of MIA LO 2 District (Major WHEAT). In my opinion, it would be a great mistake in the interests of the war effort to withdraw these troops from US Forces. I have therefore pending their transfer not included them in my calculations for the formation of I.I.I. Units in this District.

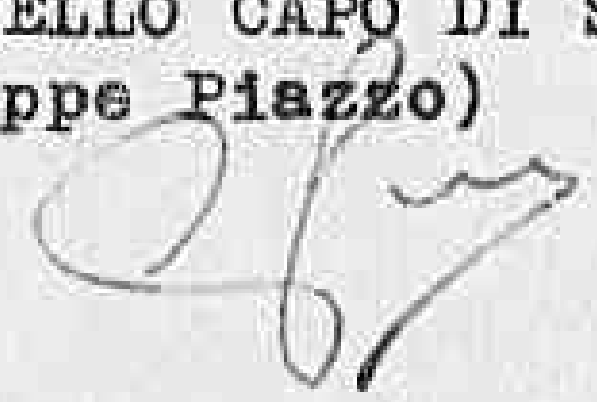

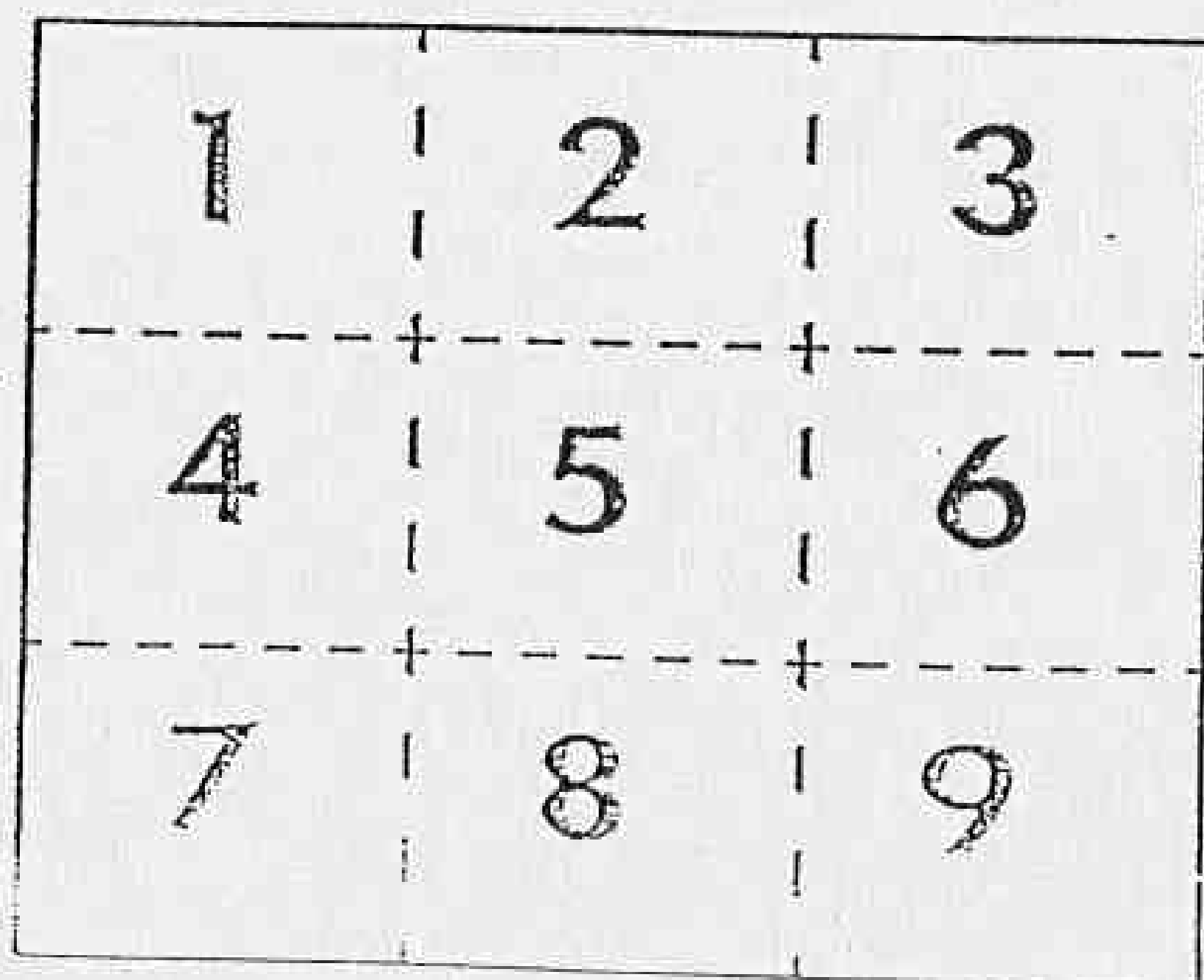
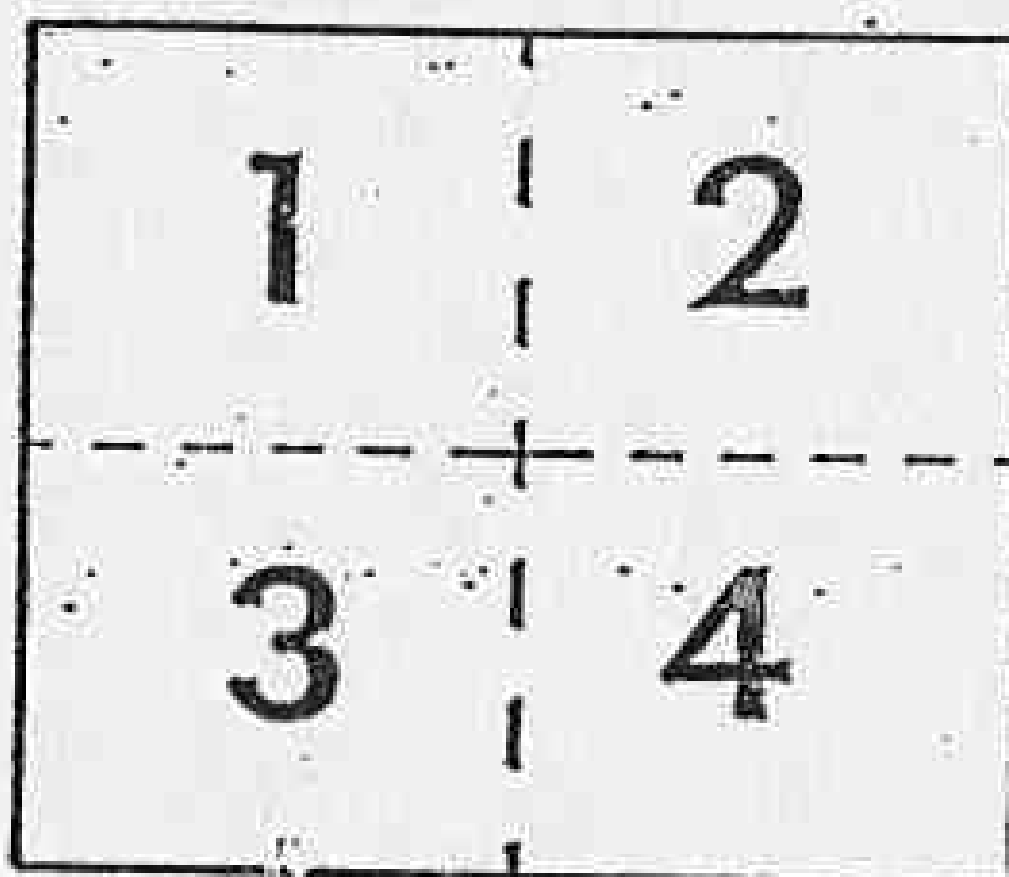

3. You will advise this office the quantities and condition of Allied clothing withdrawn.

a) Col DELL'ACQUA advanced the same proposal that suitable personnel from labour units should be immediately attached to the units to carry out work alongside skilled personnel of the units sufficiently long to learn the job, after which they will relieve personnel in the units due for demobilisation.

b) Col GORDON-BRITH stated that it was not possible to spare any personnel from labour units owing to present strained conditions and counter proposed that the should select suitable personnel for training from the 5000 of MILITARY Div to be made available at the rate of 500 per day R.E.F. 22 July at 200014 Re-charge Camp.

c) Col GORDON-BRITH accepted this solution as being satisfactory but stated that the transfer must be done gradually over a period, and at the rate of 50 men per unit per fortnight.

The change-over in 121 and 924 Coys at this rate would therefore take 15 weeks.

d) For the selection of suitable personnel it was suggested that a small detachment be placed at FOGGY Camp consisting of one or more Italian Officers and necessary staff. This detachment would be able to do the selection for both Labour and Tn and any other branch of the service requiring it.

In actual fact no more than 70% had ever been requested, and maximum labour total to date was in the region of 4000 in the 24 hours, divided into three shifts. Total effective strength is roughly 5500 in BARI.

6. a) Col DELL'ACQUA upon request of Gen LERICI asked if it could be possible to avoid using Italian soldiers for the unloading of coal as uniforms which could not be replaced,

were ruined by such labour.

b) Lt Col REID replied that only about 60 soldiers were used for the unloading of coal and that the Docks Group made a special issue to these soldiers of 2 yrs overalls, Soap and eye-shades, and that therefore the ruining of uniforms did not arise.

c) Col GORDON-JUMMIE added that no differentiation could be made between Italian and British types and therefore if there was coal to be unloaded the Italians would have to do it just as British units had to do it.

Lastly Col PORTER requested that this in units be informed by 14th Corps what had been planned so that unrest, which was prevalent due to the fact that personnel to be demobilised were becoming restive at being kept on, might be subdued.
