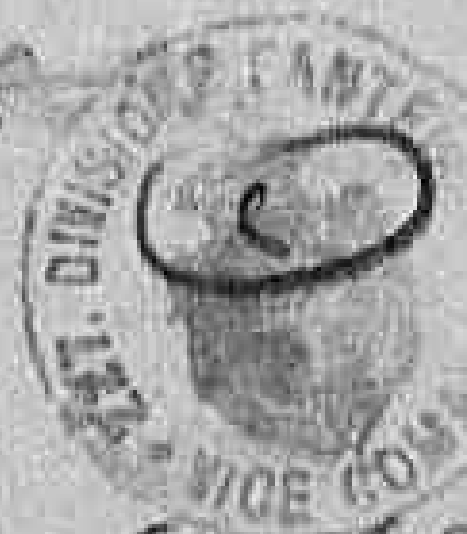

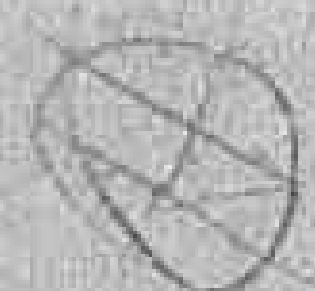

The following transfers took place, following the wishes of the M.M.I.A. L.O.'s of Bari and Naples communicated to us on the 29/12/44 and 12/1/45 respectively:

Major (Q.M.) Regular Army De Toma Domenico from Bari to Naples and Major (Q.M.) Regular Army Bompane Mariano from Naples to Bari.

I am led to believe that this was due simply to service reasons prevailing at the time and not to anything that might have been held against the two officers who, as a result of said transfers, are suffering from a period of economic and family trouble since they have been forced to leave their respective families owing to the impossibility of finding suitable accommodation at their new destinations.

We beg M.M.I.A. to kindly approve the return of Major Bompane to Naples and Major De Toma to Bari, as it is in the interest of the service, to have their minds at ease.
