1. In order to correct certain misunderstandings and to ensure that fair treatment, as regards leave, is accorded to all categories of the Italian Army, the following rulings have been forwarded by the Staff to the Ministry of War:

a. The greatest possible number of ex-cooperators will be posted to units from Egypt and Reclamation Centres, and if necessary, units may be brought over-strings, but not exceeding 20% for this purpose. Desert Commissioners will, wherever possible, post ex-cooperators to units in preference to other reinforcements held at the Desert.

b. Leave may be given to ex-cooperators held in Egypt, Reclamation Centres, etc., at the same percentage and for the same duration as for other units of the Italian Army, (at present 17%) but for this purpose ex-cooperators and other reinforcements will have to be considered as two separate blocks for the purpose of calculating reinforcements, i.e. if 1,000 ex-cooperators, and 4,000 other reinforcements are held in the Desert, 500 ex-cooperators would be sent on leave and 600 other reinforcements.

c. Service as cooperator in aid of Allied War effort is to count towards qualifying period of 6 months for the granting of leave.

d. All other leave conditions for ex-cooperators will be the same as for the rest of the Italian Army.

e. Ex-cooperators incorporated into the Italian Army on last day 45 are not considered as "repatriated" prisoners of war.

f. Prisoners of War "repatriated" to Italy (i.e. from other countries) and released by the Allies are considered as civilians for all purposes. Their leave (as civilians) is covered by War Ministry Circular No. 200/90/11 of 20 January 45. They cannot

1. In order to correct certain misunderstandings and to ensure that their treatment, as regards leave, is accorded to all categories of the Italian Army, the following rulings have been formulated by HQ MILA Rome to the Ministry of War:

a. The greatest possible number of ex-cooperators will be posted to units free from Loyola and Realization Centers, and if necessary, units may be brought over-strength, but not exceeding 20% for this purpose. Exposed Cooperator will, wherever possible, post ex-cooperators to units in preference to other reinforcements held at the Loyola.

b. Leave may be given to ex-cooperators held in Loyola, Realization Centers, etc., at the same percentage and for the same duration as for other men of the Italian Army, (at present 15%) but for this purpose ex-cooperators and other reinforcements will have to be considered as two separate blocks for the purpose of calculating reinforcements, i.e. if 2,000 cooperators, and 4,000 other reinforcements are held in the Loyola, 200 ex-cooperators would be sent on leave and 600 other reinforcements.

c. Service to cooperators in old of Allied war effort is to count towards qualifying period of 6 months for the granting of leave.

d. All other leave conditions for ex-cooperators will be the same as for the rest of the Italian Army.

e. Ex-cooperators are not to be sent into the Italian Army as late as they are not considered as designated prisoners of war.

f. Prisoners of War Repatriated to Italy (i.e. from other countries) and released by the Allies are considered as civilians for all purposes. Their leave (as civilians) is covered by War Ministry Circular No. 200500/11 of 30 January 45. They cannot be incorporated into the new Italian Army until after the conclusion of their 30 (or 40) days leave.

g. The above decisions are to be circulated immediately to all Italian Commanders concerned, and are to be read out and fully explained to all men on parade.

h. Sub para(g) above will be accomplished immediately and a letter confirming its implementation will be forwarded to this office not later than 15 Aug 45.

(a) The control line for movement of Italian Army, and Italian Cooperater personnel an authorised leave is now the line river PIAVE from mouth to road-river crossing, 66494 thence road VITTORIO VENETO 66712, - PIERRE DI CADORE B 7562 - S. STEFANO DI CADORE B8875 thence due NORTH to AUSTRIAN frontier.

(b) No moves for any Italian personnel is authorised EAST of this line nor into prohibited frontier zone, i.e. belt 25 Km in depth along FRENCH, SWISS and AUSTRIAN frontiers, except as in paras C and E below.

(c) Demobilised personnel may move EAST and NORTH of lines sec (c-o) above with proper documents from M.M.I.A. (i.e. MMIA; LCs) will countersign Demobilisation papers in cases where the individuals home is EAST or NORTH of the control lines)

(d) Italian personnel on duty may travel as far as the Control Lines sec (a +b) above with " Foglio Di Viaggio" and Identity Documents.

(e) Italian personnel on duty may proceed EAST and NORTH of lines sec (a+b) above only with permission of 15 Army Group or 8 Army.

1. General I have now received information from MIA regarding Allied restrictions on travel by serving Italian military personnel summarized for your guidance in the following para. Travel by personnel other than serving military is NOT of course an MIA concern.

2. Army Security Control Line (ASCL). ASCL now runs as follows: River PO as far west as intersection by extension of straight line PARMA - LA SPEZIA; straight line PARMA - LA SPEZIA, excluding towns of PARMA - LA SPEZIA, from the control area.

3. Travel SOUTH of ASCL

- (a) DUTY (i) Unrestricted provided identity documents are in possession.
(ii) "Viaggio di Viaggio" does not require MIA IO signature.
(b) LEAVE (i) Unrestricted provided leave passes are in possession.
(ii) Leave passes do NOT require MIA IO signature.

4. Travel NORTH of ASCL

- (a) DUTY (i) Authority to travel must be obtained from the Allied Army, District or Base Section controlling the area in which the destination lies.
(ii) "Viaggio di Viaggio" must be countersigned by

- (iv) Authority will only be given when the personnel concerned are required by the Army, District or Base Section.

(b) LEAVE (1) Authority to travel must be obtained from the Allied Army, District or Base Section controlling the area in which the destination lies.

(ii) "Poglio di Viaggio" must be countersigned by MIA IO.

(iii) "Poglio di Viaggio" must quote the reference and date of the actual Army, District or Base Section authority.

(iv) Application for such authority will be made through Ministry of War and NOT MIA IO, and only in urgent compassionate cases.

1. (a) MMIA LO's are authorized to counter-sign duty travel passes, i.e. "Foglio di Viaggio" for Italian Military travelling into Army Areas. Recently liberated territory is, however, strictly out of bounds to Italian Military. Only in rare cases when Italian Military are specifically requested by 5 and 8 Armies can passes be counter-signed by you. The Army authority must be quoted on the "Foglio di Viaggio".

(b) Duty travel is unrestricted as far north as the Rear Army Security Control Line (see our INT/109 of 30 Apr att for easy reference). The "Foglio di Viaggio" does not require your counter-signature but the Italian Military must be in possession of their Identity Documents.

(c) NO passes will be issued to Italian civilians.

(d) Leave:- Italian Military on leave in uniform may travel with leave passes instead of standard movement of civilian passes as far North as Rear Army Security Control Line. These passes do not require your counter-signature. To travel North of that line, Army, Base or District authority must be obtained (in accordance with para 6 of A/17 of 30 Dec-44). This authority will be quoted on the leave pass and countersigned by you. 8 in LO/1/AQ

2. NO passes will be issued to places in the Region of VENEZIA GIULIA.
