
"Are you an Italian officer? You are British I don't salute British officers only Italian."

As a rule it is tried to obtain a confession. If this is not forthcoming and there is a dispute between superior and inferior, the word of the superior is valid.

7. No special document is used for normal disciplinary punishments. The superior that punishes, informs in writing the common superior (the Garrison Commander if the soldier is of another regt) stating offence committed and punishment awarded. This makes the Coy Commander questioning the punished soldier, receive a verbal statement and fixes the punishment that is subsequently communicated to the punished soldier.



The incident seems to have been provoked by one of the British Military, who calling himself an agent had ordered the Italian military to evacuate the place. Soldier GARRINI RENATO, having the suspicion that the British Military did not belong to the Police, asked him for his documents.

The British Military, resenting such a request, hit with his fists GARRINI, who responded similarly. A fight started thus, to which the Carmela FERRARA also took part, on behalf of the British Military.

Other soldiers taking part in it, the incident was finally terminated, and the Italian military returned to their unit (Scuola Maltoni) leaving the British military in the restaurant.

About 15 minutes later, the two British military, accompanied by three civilians, went to the Scuola Maltoni billets, asking to have a talk with the Duty officer. The soldier on duty asked them to wait, and went inside the billets in order to call Sergeant Major DI GIORGIO. He had taken only a few steps, when one of the British military fired against him two pistol shots, and fortunately missed him. Hearing the shots, an Italian soldier, DI GIUSEPPE, armed with sub-machine gun, ran out, and at the same time one of the British military fired another shot, missing again. DE GIUSEPPE, in order to frighten the British military, fired his sub-machine gun. The two British military, who were slightly intoxicated, went away.

While checking wagon 143653 on 'D' Dock NAPLES loaded yesterday with small arms etc for VERONA - HQ 4 CAR, it was noticed by a civilian worker that a box containing pistols 38 had been tampered with. On checking consignment of 91 pistols it was found that 56 were missing. I reported this matter to the Italian Officer IC (Major AS MEIELLA) who in turn advised the Territorial Command HQ. During this Officers absence I had reason to suspect that the guard who were on duty on the train being loaded knew something of the matter. I requested that Marshalllo GIUSEPPE PETRILLI should organise a search and inspect the mens' kit and also the vehicle which was to be used for the return to billets. This was done and 3 of the guard were found to be in possession of some of the missing pistols a total of 29 being found one man admitting having dumped 8 into the sea. This has to be verified although several can be seen from the quay in clear water. There are still missing 27 until it can be ascertained if it is possible to recover those in the sea. The men in question placed under close arrest and were passed over th their Coy Commander a Lt col Italian Army to be dealt with.

The matter has been reported to the Italian Military Police by the HQ and a military Police Guard has now been detailed for guard duties.
