10 Territorial Command

1. This HQ was approached by Welfare officer 10 Territorial Command, for advice as to ways and means of purchasing surplus NAATI goods for sale in Italian Army Canteens, canteen shops etc.
2. After a personal interview with Admiral DRAYTON one of the Heads of NAATI who is at present in ITALY, I gather dealing with the disposal of NAATI surplus goods, I was informed that negotiations were in progress for complete disposal to one buyer and that if this deal went through no surplus would be available for sale to Italian Army direct from NAATI. If however this deal is not completed NAATI might consider sale to Italian Army.

3. It would appear however that any such transaction would be far beyond the scope of any one Territorial Command and should be a matter for the War Ministry for the following reasons :-

- (a) NAATI, not unilaterally, are keen to make a deal for complete disposal rather than for smaller quantities and selected items.
- (b) The approximate total for disposal is somewhere between three and four million pounds sterling.
- (c) Payment would have to be in sterling, local currency would not be accepted.

4. From the above it does not seem that there is much hope of 10 Territorial Command being able to make a deal.

It is possible however that Welfare Branch War Ministry might be interested.

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
