The music master CORNIELLO Luigi, requested by the undersigned, has immediately exhibited a "NORTON" (Allied) motorcycle, apparently unefficient and with new tyres.

CORNIELLO Luigi has declared, and proved, that in July 1944 he came in possession of the motorcycle, which had been left in a field of his property by a Canadian soldier. The motorcycle had been left there as it had been hit by a gun shell.

CORNIELLO denounced the motorcycle to the Canadian Major JOHN E. BUILDER, 5 I.A.A. Canadian Regt., having as a witness the then Sindaco of ALVIGNANO P. FAGLIUCA. Major BUILDER, who was then the Senior Officer in Command of the troops in that territory, gave him a statement, which read as follows :

" 22/6/1944 - the owner of this note has reported to me that a Canadian Soldier left at his home a motorcycle. This is to certify that said motorcycle has not been stolen. Bearer does not know the name, nor the Regt. of the soldier, and he will keep the motorcycle until it will be collected. If the owner will not collect it, the motorcycle will be handed over to Canadian Police".

CORNIELLO, as soon as he was in possession of the above statement, went to see an American woman, Signora FARAONE Flora, who translated it.

CORNIELLO, who is in possession of the original statement, affirms that a few days later the Canadian Police went to his house in order to collect the m/cycle, but could not effect it as there were no means of transporting it away. At the same time the Canadian Police ordered CORNIELLO not to hand over the m/cycle to any other authority, even Allied, as the m/cycle was to remain at their disposal.

This much has been proved by Maestro CORNIELLO, who has kept good conduct, political and moral, and has no previous convictions against him. The m/cycle has now been sequestered, and is in this Caserma ad disposal of H.

Il maestro di musica CORNIELLO Luigi fu Nicola e di ROSSI Vincenza, nato in Alvignano il 21-6-1907, ivi domiciliato al corso U. I°, a richiesta del sottoscritto, ha immediatamente esibito una motocicletta "NORTON" alleata, apparentemente guasta nella parti: meccaniche e munita di copertoni nuovi.=

L'anzidetto ha dichiarato, provandolo, che nel luglio 1944 venne in possesso della motocicletta che un soldato canadese abbandonò in un suo terraneo disabitato perché colpito da cannonata. Immediatamente, presente l'allora sindaco di Alvignano PAGLIUCA Pasquale, ne fece denuncia al maggiore canadese JOHN E. BUILDER della 5^a L.A.A. Regg. Canadese, ufficiale più elevato in grado delle truppe che trovavansi in questa giurisdizione, che gli rilasciò un attestato che, tradotto, dice:

"Il 22/6/1944-il possessore di questo biglietto rapportò a me che un soldato canadese lasciò a casa sua una motocicletta. Questo è per certificato ~~exlaxterraxfinexhonx~~ che essa non è rubata, egli non conosce il nome né il reggimento e la terra finché non vengano a prenderla. Se non riescano a prenderla sarà girata alla polizia canadese.".=

Il CORNIELLO, appena in possesso dell'attestato anzidetto si recò dalla signora americana FARAONE Flora in Tommaselli, dalla quale ottenne la traduzione della chiarazione ottenuta dal maggiore canadese.=

il CORNIELLO, che è rimasto in possesso dell'originale della dichiarazione anzidetta, ha affermato pure che qualche giorno dopo la polizia canadese si portò a casa sua per ritirare la motocicletta, ma ciò non fece per mancanza di mezzi di trasporto ed al contempo ordinò di non consentire ad altre autorità, anche alleate, di asportare la moto che doveva rimanere sempre a loro disposizione.=

Quanto dimostrato dal maestro CORNIELLO, che è di buona condotta morale e politica e senza precedenti penali, deve ritenersi veritiero.= La moto suddetta è stata sequestrata e trovasi in questa caserma a disposizione di codesto superiore comando.=
