Following all preceding communications, we inform you that during the month of September the American - PBS - Q 5 N 85 - detached at Maddaloni, has taken 1,71 tons of mineral coal from the Military Establishment of Maddaloni.

That makes in all a total of 748,14 tons of coal that the above PBS has retired from said Establishment of Maddaloni.

The coal that the Military Bakery has received from the PBS Deposit of Baguoli amounts to 354,75 tons, it still has to take other 30 tons; so making a total of 384,75 tons that PBS has given back to ^{the} Italian M.M. Military Administration.

Therefore this has still a credit with PBS of 363,49 tons of mineral coal.

When asked by us, MMIA assured us that all the coal taken from Maddaloni would have been ³¹⁰⁸ returned by PBS to us every time it were needed, taking it from the reserves of coal constituted by PBS at Baguoli.

Now PBS has informed us that after the above mentioned 30 tons it has no intention to give more coal the Italian Military Administration.

Being in contrast with what the promise given by MMIA, we beg you to obtain from the American Command to let us take from Baguoli the whole amount of coal given to the Americans in Maddaloni.

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Facendo seguito alla precedenti comunicazioni, si segnala che nel mese di settembre u.s. il Comando Americano -Reparto P.B.S.- Q.5N85 -, distaccato a Maddaloni, ha ritirato dallo Stabilimento Militare di Maddaloni tonnellate 1,71 di carbone minerale.

Con detto prelevamento il quantitativo totale di carbone minerale ritirato dal Comando Americano -Reparto PBS- dallo stabilimento di Maddaloni ammonta a tonnellate 748,14.

Il quantitativo di carbone ricevuto dal Panificio Militare e ritirato dal Deposito di Bagnoli del P.B.S. è di tonnellate 354,75; inoltre sono in corso di ritiro tonnellate 30 ora assegnate; in totale sono tonnellate 384,65 che la P.B.S. ha restituito all'A.M. Italiana.

Pertanto l'Amministrazione Militare Italiana è ancora in credito verso la P.B.S. di tonnellate 363,49 di carbone minerale. 3705

Codesta M.M.I.A. ebbe ad assicurare, in seguito a richiesta della scrivente, che tutto il carbone ritirato da Maddaloni sarebbe stato restituito dalla P.B.S. di mano in mano che ~~fosse~~ questa Direzione ne avesse avuto la necessità. Il carbone da restituirsi doveva essere prelevato dalle riserve costituite dalla P.B.S. a Bagnoli.

Ora la P.B.S. ha segnalato alla scrivente che esaurita l'assegnazione delle 30 tonnellate, di cui è cenno sopra, non intende fare altre consegne di carbone all'A.M. Italiana.

Ciò è in contrasto con quanto affermato da codesta M.M.I.A.; e pertanto si prega di intervenire presso il Comando Americano, affinché la scrivente possa ritirare a Bagnoli l'intero quantitativo di carbone ceduto al Reparto Americano di Maddaloni.

1. Attached are copies of tally-cut, dated 16/12/45, for Timber from Royal Estates.

2. Following is information on buck slip sent from QM to BPA on 30 March 1945.

Reference is made to the recent telephone conversation between Major Reuper - Major McCarthy concerning firewood procured by the Quartermaster, P & C Division from the Kings Estate at Tombole. The wood was obtained during the period 16 Dec. 1944 to 25 March 1945, and amounted to 1627 metric tons. All wood was furnished in meter lengths.

Recently representatives of the Kings Estate presented this office with invoices for wood delivered. Payment has not been made, as it is not known whether the King's Estate is the personal property of the King, or whether it is actually Italian Government property. MFOUSA letter of 3 January 1945, File No. 49-132/008 D-O, subject "Payment of Army Bills" prohibits payment to the Italian Government or its agencies without first referring claim for payment to MFOUSA.

Therefore, before any action can be taken, towards settlement of the account, it will be necessary for this office to obtain information as to the ownership of the King's Estate at Tombole. It is requested that your office furnish the information.

3. To date, this is the only information this office has on record in the files of the P & C Division. No answer to the above quoted letter is in the files.
