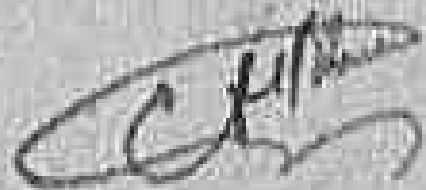

Nineteen Nº 2 Sets (Nº 9 Cdn. ME.II) to enable communication to be set up between ROME and Legions in the following cities:-

TURIN, ALESSANDRIA, GENOA, MILAN, PADUA, BOLOGNA, VERONA, BOLOGNA, FLORENCE, ANCONA, LECORNO, CHIETI, NAPLES, BARI, CATANZARO, MESSINA, PALERMO, CAGLIARI.

(c) Two Legion HQs in ROME.

Three Nº. 9 Sets for communication between Carabinieri HQs in ROME and the two Legions in ROME. It is not necessary to have high powered sets for these two Legions to communicate with Carabinieri GRQ.

(d) Twenty Legion HQs.

There are twenty Legions in Italy, Sicily and Sardinia and they are divided into one hundred and eleven Gruppi. One hundred and thirty one Nº. 9. Sets are required for communication between Legions and Gruppi.

(e) It is impossible to equip every Carabinieri station with wireless, but in order that radio communication may be

possible, in times of trouble and disorder, it is proposed that three No. 9. Sets be kept at Legion HQs, together with trained operators. Total required sixty No. 9. Sets.

If trouble is expected, or is occurring in a town or village, a No. 9 Set could be taken out by car to the nearest Carabinieri station, and kept there whilst trouble lasts. This would enable the Legion Commander to keep in touch by radio with the situation, whilst remaining in Legion HQ in some large town. The set would return to Legion HQ when the situation became normal.

4. A total of 218 No. 9 Sets are required for this plan, but only 70 No. 9 Sets are available and the difference is made up of 148 No. 19 H.F. Sets.

5. The whole of this radio equipment is at No 3 Sub-Depot, 557 B.O.D. Ponte Cognano, near Salerno.

6. Arrangements have been made for Captain Clarke of No 10 B.L.U. at Naples (telephone Naples 55802) to accept delivery, which will commence almost immediately. The total weight is about 200 tons and it is considered that about 15 railway wagons will be required to move the whole consignment.

7. Captain Clarke will arrange for the rail transport, from Salerno to Rome, through the Italian Territorial Command at Naples.

8. Captain Clarke will require the services of one Carabinieri Officer, English speaking if possible, and a small number of Carabinieri to act as guards during the loading and the train journey to Rome. Will you please arrange for the Carabinieri Legion Commander at Naples to supply Captain Clarke with one Officer and the necessary Carabinieri for guard duties at a time and date to be notified by Captain Clarke.

9. CC.RR. GHQ will be responsible for the distribution of these radio Sets to Legions after the Sets have arrived in Rome.

10. CC.RR. GHQ will arrange in conjunction with the Italian War Ministry, and any other Italian Authority which may be involved, the following:-

(a) Adequate training for the Carabinieri operators:-

11. Consideration will have to be given regarding the use of codes or any special procedure by the Carabinieri.
12. Each station will have to be tested thoroughly in case of difficulties or non-reception due to range, interference etc. Different signals may have to be used in some cases and Sets moved to other casernes due to poor reception in certain areas.

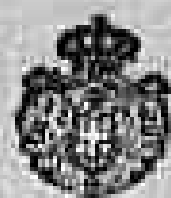

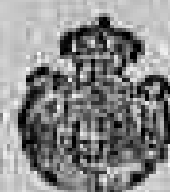

1. The Ministry of War should be in a position to inform you as to whether it is intended to replace, green jackets and trousers, with khaki pattern. In the event of a further difficulty in this respect, please refer the matter to this HQ, who will investigate the matter and assist as possible.

2. Regarding collars for shirts. It is presumed that these are of the old British pattern, for which no collar is provided. It is suggested that these be adjusted by local manufacture of collars from material detached from the tail or sleeves of the shirt. In the latter instance, shirts would be highly suitable for summer wear.

1. The situation of 5 Brigade CC.RR. with regard to clothing in general is that every man has one complete uniform. This uniform is in many cases in a deplorable condition and frequently consists of a mixture of Allied and Italian uniforms, both summer and winter patterns.
2. Very few CC.RR. have any change of clothing, and as a commencement another set of uniform, including cap, boots and underwear is urgently needed. This figure may be put roughly at 10,000 complete sets for the brigade.
3. Morale and efficiency are both seriously affected by the clothing conditions, CC.RR. clad in variegated rags cannot and do not command respect and the men themselves are painfully conscious of their appearance.
4. A striking example is furnished by the Italian soldiers of combat groups and the L. of C. troops. The first, well dressed and equipped, present a soldierly appearance, the second appear slovenly and inefficient in ill fitting uniforms, but even the latter at least have uniformity of clothing.
