SUBJECT: Truck AUSTIN Utility M.5287591.

As per instructions received yesterday from you by telephone, this morning I went to 608 G.C.T. Workshops where the commanding British Sergeant stated:-

- he had not received any telephone warning about my arrival and my task;
- that if Major Mac Neal of the 3 District M.P. wishes a report on the causes and responsibility of the theft of the a/m vehicle, he must ask for it and he will receive it directly.

PARTICULARS OF THE FACT

- 1) The 7 June, I sent an urgent order to the section for the repression of Brigandage in Aversa.
- 2) The driver after having delivered his message on the return trip in order not to be run into by an American jeep driven by Cpl. BAYLON C. 44031108 Knichfen, 53rd Crl. Ammo. Co. his with the front right side against the a cart. Thus, the body of the vehicle was damaged, the right light was broken and the radiator was pushed in.
- 3) The driver of our vehicle is a licenced driver and a military of career. He drove the car as far as Naples.
- 4) On the morning of the 10th the AUSTIN truck was taken to 608 Workshops to be repaired.
- 5) The 608 G.C.T. on the 15th informed me, by letter, that the car had been stolen from the Workshop.
- 6) With another letter dated 18th the Workshop informed me that the vehicle had been found in a condition that it could not be repaired and therefore it had been handed to the 416 CRASC R.V.P. and that a communication concerning the matter had been forwarded to CRASC 26 Gen Coln.
- 7) I add that the driver of the American jeep mentioned that the brakes were not functioning well.
- 8) Confidentially I was told that a German POW, forging a trip ticket, had left the Camp with the AUSTIN truck and had not returned.

TRANSLATION

Amongst the German prisoners of War of the 608 German General Transport (Workshops) discontent exists, they complain:

- the indetermined and perhaps long period of internment;
- the fact - they say ^{THAT} they do not receive cigarettes.

Amongst the others, there is one, heavily built, old, attached to the office, who lived in Naples for many years before the war, he traded at that time fruit and vegetables. He boasts many acquaintances in Naples and vicinity.

There is another one, an electrician of Cecoslovak extraction, who has many possibilities of going out from the camp, same as the mechanics. He complains, because his compatriots are co-operators and are free, instead he is a prisoner and is trying his best to get away. In order to reach his aim he has started friendships outside the Camp.

Tra i prigionieri tedeschi del 508 German General Transport (Workshops) esiste malcontento perchè lamentano:

- il periodo indeterminato e forse lungo dello stato di captività;

- perchè dicono - non ricevono sigarette.

Tra di essi ve n'è uno di corporatura grossa, anziano, addetto all'ufficio il quale è stato lungo tempo a Napoli avanti la guerra perchè commerciava all'ingrosso in frutta e ortaggi, il quale vanta di avere molte amicizie in Napoli e dintorni.

Ve n'è un altro, un elettricista di nazionalità cecoslovacca, il quale ha larga possibilità di uscire dal campo, come i meccanici. Costui lamenta che, mentre altri suoi compatrioti sono cooperatori e liberi, egli è prigioniero e si dà da fare per sottrarsi alla prigionia.

Si crede che abbia allacciate relazioni esterne al campo per raggiungere tale intento.

1. Considerable difficulty is being experienced by this HQ, in effecting a true appreciation of the number of vehicles in possession of Legions and Mobile Bns of CC.RR.
2. Recent returns submitted by Liaison Officers vary substantially with those submitted by GHQ, CC.RR.
3. It is realised in both cases, the data is compiled by Unit HQs, and incorrect returns are in no way attributed to Liaison Officers: it is interesting to note, returns from Liaison Officers generally show a larger holding of vehicles than those submitted by GHQ.
4. It may well be, Commanders consider a true return of vehicles held by them, will cause penalisation by transference of vehicles to other units.
5. If this impression in fact exists, it is to be erased immediately: this HQ will guarantee that such action will not be taken UNLESS the holdings of a particular type of vehicle are in excess of War Establishment, adjustment therefore being necessary, or it is considered essential for immediate operational requirements.
6. Liaison Officers are requested to emphasise the importance of this matter, and ensure to their utmost, vehicle returns submitted to GHQ by units, are rendered both accurately and promptly.
7. A further consideration with reference to vehicles requires emphasis. As stated in CC.RR. Bulletin No.1., it is essential unserviceable vehicles beyond repair are disposed of immediately: failure to do so may lead to inefficient vehicles remaining in possession of units, and efficient vehicles, although available, not being issued.
8. Equally, economy is to be considered: vehicles mechanically unsound, will be handed in without delay, for repair by Italian Army Territorial Workshops: - requisitioned vehicles will NOT be serviced by these workshops. Vehicles which are efficient, but requiring tires and tubes, will remain with Legions: supply of these items is being pressed by this HQ, and it is hoped the position will improve in the near future.
9. Compliance with the requests made in this letter, will assist appreciably in the re-organisation of CC.RR. transport.

2. A directive has been issued to the Provincial Authorities by the Ministry, that the monthly requirements of COMV must be met in full and not cut down as has happened on previous occasions.
3. 5 Brigades have had no difficulties in obtaining supplies additional to their normal requirements in the case of emergencies and only arising.
4. As POL is given by groups from provincial authorities the wastage of POL used in actually drawing supplies is not considered of great importance.
5. In principle however it seems clear that COMV supplies should be drawn through Army channels in order to avoid COMV having to depend on the compliance of local authorities which may not always be willingly given, and also to avoid the dependence, even indirectly, of the COMV on yet another Ministry.
6. The point that GIP local supplies may fail in an emergency is regarded as most important, especially in the case of serious disturbances where the sabotage of petrol points is a possibility that cannot be overlooked, especially as legions carry no reserves in appreciable quantities.
