2. Enquiries were made from ADST Naples Area as to the responsibility for repairs and were informed that this was not an RASC responsibility, (ME 22/1 dated 14 Feb 46 and 248/ST dated 19 Feb 46 refer).
3. 724 L of C Wksps were then instructed to inform the unit that as repairs to their vehicle were not a REME responsibility, the vehicle should be removed as soon as possible, (ME 22/1 dated 21 Feb 46 refers).
4. 3 Italian G.T. Coy 'W' Platoon were informed by the workshop by letter on 25 Feb 46 of the situation and instructed to arrange collection of the vehicle, but this and subsequent communications have failed to bring any response.
5. May the unit please be instructed to remove the vehicle forthwith or disposal instructions please be given.

1. With reference to an inspection made by officers of 10 BLU at the clothing Depot of FRATTACCIONE - FRATTACCIONE, who ascertained that the transport situation was critical owing to deficiencies of spare parts, the following points are brought to your attention : -

- (i) Lorry 5 ton OM ROD RE 78223 - 5590. This lorry requires 1 tyre 230/20. Request for replacing this tyre was forwarded two months ago to the 10 Repair Centre at AGANO. Engine in good condition. Body in good condition. Lorries needs maintenance and small repairs, being an old one.
- (ii) Lorry 3 ton SPA 38 - RE 136135 - 5970. All tyres worn out. No spare wheels. Superstructure in bad condition. Needs repairing and maintenance owing to worn parts.
- (iii) Truck 1 ton SPA 159 RE 67413 - 1209. Two tyres worn out and two in bad condition. No spare wheels. Superstructure in bad state.

All above-mentioned vehicles need complete spares and tools.

2. Three other 3 ton lorries were handed back last November as U/S. Replacement for these was asked for through Territorial HQ.

3. FRATTACCIONE and FRATTACCIONE Stores have often necessity to transport small quantities of stores, or personnel, to NAFLES, and need a light car. We suggest that a 3 ton vehicle be substituted for a lighter vehicle.

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3. FRATTAGLIORE and FRATTALINCE Stores have often necessity to ~~trifugare~~ ^{small} quantities of stores, or personnel, to NAFFES, and need a light car. We suggest that a 3 ton vehicle be substituted for a lighter vehicle.

4. In order to speed up repairs, as i.e. tyre springs, electricity, carburation, gears, we suggest that permission be granted to have these repairs done in civilian workshops. Military workshops are overworked, and their location is distant. They need authority from their HQ before starting any repair. For this reason our vehicles are often immobilised on account of small damages which could be easily repaired in civilian workshops.

5. Actually we can dispose of 10,000 lire every three months for each car. Obviously this amount is not sufficient for minor repairs, as the prices are so very high.
