1. An enquiry was made to War Office asking for information concerning those families who were tenants before coming to OMF and who on the cessation of the theatre will have to move in UK to which to go.

2. The following is an extract from the reply received from the War Office.

"The return of families now living in OMF with their husbands to the UK raises certain problems regarding housing accommodation in Great Britain.

In the acute housing shortage that now prevails the Local Housing Authorities are required to requisition all empty houses. In addition, the Rent and Mortgage Restriction Acts make it very difficult for the landlords of certain houses to re-let possession in the case of unfurnished lettings.

The possibility of obtaining special protection for houses of Jewish personnel whose families proceeded to OMF under the War Relocation Act is being investigated. It is suggested, however, that it may not be possible to obtain any special facilities for such cases. It is desirable that anyone contemplating returning with his family to U.S. should consider this aspect of the question.

Briefly, the position is as follows:-

- (a) With regard to unfurnished houses, it will, then, be likely to have been requisitioned by the Local Authority the day the power in this respect. During the period that a house is requisitioned the Homeless Persons Authority pays compensation in the form of rent to the person who would have been entitled to the possession of the house but

1. An enquiry was made to War Office asking for information concerning those families who were tenants before coming to GMP and who on the evacuation of the theatre will have no means in UK to which to go.

2. The following is an extract from the reply received from the War Office.

"The return of families now living in GMP with their husbands to the UK raises certain problems regarding housing accommodation in Great Britain.

In the acute housing shortage that now prevails the local Housing Authorities are required to re-allocate all empty houses. In addition, the Rent and Mortgage Restrictions Acts makes it very difficult for the landlord of certain houses to regain possession in the case of unfurnished lettings.

The possibility of obtaining special protection for houses of Service personnel whose families proceeded to GMP under the Evacuees has been investigated. It is regretted, however, that it was not found possible to obtain any special facilities for protection. It is desirable that anyone contemplating returning with his family to U.K. should consider this aspect of the question.

Briefly, the position is as follows:-

(a) With regard to unfurnished houses, if, while, those are likely to have been requisitioned by the local authority who have the power in this respect. During the period that a house is requisitioned the Requisitioning Authority pays compensation in the form of rent to the person who would have been entitled to the possession of the house but for the Requisitioning Order. The Housing Authority also assumes responsibility for most of the outgoings on the property and pays a certain amount of charges for the maintenance of the property in every day expenses. Although compensation is paid it may be a very long time before possession of their houses is restored. Possession can be restored. In the case of Service and reservemen requiring possession of their houses requisitioned by the local authority...

having anticipated the latter, do, in fact take all possible steps by finding alternative accommodations for the occupants of the houses to free them for the returning Servicemen.

In the existing housing shortage, however, such procedure cannot always be carried out for a considerable time. Attention is drawn to HQ 602/16 in connection with de-queuing.

(b) Where a house, which is subject to the Rent and Mortgage Restriction Act, (that is to say one which has a rental value of £100 in London and £75 in the Provinces, in Section 270) was in possession of a family prior to their proceeding to GHF and on their proceedings was let or sub-let on an informal arrangement - the tenant or sub-tenant - residing in on the return of the family, the position is as follows. Such an arrangement does not fulfil the agreement out of the Rent and Mortgage Restriction Act, and if a tenant fails to honour his previous possession cannot be obtained without an application to the Court. In that event the Court can make an official order to adjust the tenant only after reviewing all the circumstances, and a primary consideration in such cases is the question "to which of these rivals ultimately to the possession of the house would an adverse decision by the Court cause the greatest hardship."

(c) When a house has been let in not subject to the provisions of the Rent and Mortgage Restriction Act, and a legal agreement for its re-possession at the end of a definite term can be entered.

(d) If the holder of his wife was the tenant of a controlled house on a short term agreement to include a clause reversion possession when the term expired, if the house was left empty, and any re-let it to another tenant. In this event neither the holder nor his wife will have any redress on return to the U.K.

The whole question is a complex one, and personnel affected will be well advised to take legal advice as to their interests in their houses in the United Kingdom, with a view to obtaining possession when their families return from C.A.F.

family prior to their proceeding to the United States on their own behalf, the court will not subject them to the provisions of the War Relocation Authority Act, and a legal agreement for its re-possession of the land of a relative can be entered.

(c) If the soldier or his wife has the benefit of a controlled house on a short term agreement to land, the court will recover possession when the term expires, if the house was left empty, the way to let it to another tenant. In this event neither the soldier nor his wife will have any redress to return to the U.S.

The above question is a complex one, and personnel affected will be well advised to take legal advice as to their interests in their houses in the United Kingdom, with a view to obtaining possession when their families return from U.S.A., with families in this country.
