Further to this Office letter 377 A of 23 Dec 46. A representative of the Mission has lately been called to GRC for the express purpose of discussing questions affecting Officers of the Mission. The following replies were given to questions raised:-

1. Families of PLUs (less 4, 5 and 12) would in all probability be evacuated to UK WOT before 1 Feb 46.
2. The question of the return of families of PL 4, 5 and 12 PLUs would be taken up later. Probable return to UK March/April pending.
3. Officers who have completed a PENSION tour and have either:-
(a) Taken LEUOP
or (b) PENSION
or (c) Deferred PENSION.
will be sent to UK. Payment of PENSION rights will be cancelled.
4. Officers on first or second tour PENSION who have had a period of 12 months in UK/LEUOP above their leave entitlement (i.e. 2 weeks disembarkation leave after PENSION tour and 2 weeks embarkation leave) will in all probability be posted to Italy. It may be pointed out that few if any appointments either staff or Regimental will be available in UK with the possible exception of a few in BTA.
5. All Officers would be reverted to Regimental duty, especially would this apply to SA Officers and Officers of services. As far as could be seen the only exception to this rule would be:-
(a) Outstanding Staff Officers.
(b) Staff Liaison Officers who have yet to complete the necessary qualifying period for Qualification Pay. Future deployment would be made to place these latter Officers in that they might continue in a Staff appointment.
6. Owing to the large number of Officers who will be "on the market" consequent upon the increased speed of "run down" in this theatre, it is possible that an Officer who has deferred his release to "General Demobilisation" might

The War Office consider that the practice of long take-over periods between officers is most undesirable, especially during this period of serious officer shortage, and direct that the following rules, regarding both take-over and probationary period, will be brought into operation immediately.

1. Staff longer attachments will be limited to one month.
2. An officer on probation for service with another unit, or with a view to transfer to another unit, will be held on the strength of the unit with which he is serving during the probationary period, and will be struck off the strength of his former unit.
3. An officer on probation to fill an appointment (e.g. Instructor) will not be attached for a period longer than 10 days.
4. The maximum period allowed for Double Banking to occur during the take-over of any appointment will, therefore, be fixed at 10 days, and the practice of attaching officers pending absorption for indefinite periods will cease with effect from date of receipt of this letter.

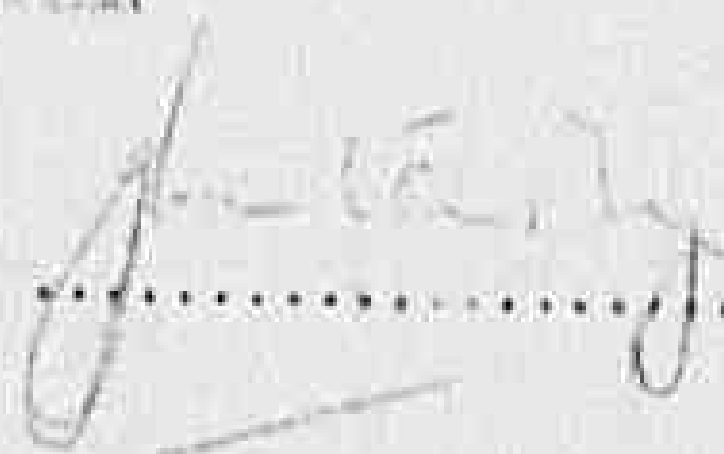

It is expected that by 1st June, 1946 the Sudan Defence Force will be reduced to an establishment appropriate to its post-war function of an Internal Security Force.

The Sudan, which is not a British colony, is administered by the Sudan Government under the Dominion of Great Britain and Egypt. As an Internal Security Force the Sudan Defence Force will be controlled and paid for by the Sudan Government as before the war, and local rates of pay and allowances will be in force.

The post-war S.D.F. will comprise four units besides the ancillary services. They are:-- Camel Corps, Eastern Arab Corps, Western Arab Corps, Equatorial Corps. Each Corps consists of a number of independent companies of either mounted infantry, motorised infantry, or in the Equatorial Corps, marching infantry. All appointments up to and including Command of Corps and a few staff appointments at L.C. if the Force are available to seconded officers.

SELECTION FOR APPOINTMENT IN POST-WAR ESTABLISHMENT.

Appointments in the Post-War establishment cannot be made until it has been approved and implemented, but REGULAR ARMY officers desirous of serving in the post-war S.D.F. will now be given the opportunity of filling appointments in the existing establishment, on Imperial rates of pay and allowances, with a view to filling the appointments in the post-war establishment as soon as implemented.

It is hoped to fill all the vacancies between 1 January, 1946 and 1 June, 1946.

Selection will be made by the G.O.C. Camel Corps in the Sudan (Commandant of the S.D.F.), and applications should be addressed through the normal channels. Full details of terms and conditions of service may be obtained by direct application to H.Q. The Sudan.

It is hoped to fill all the vacancies by, or on, 1 January, 1946 and 1 June, 1946.

Selection will be made by the G.O.C. Command in the Sudan (Commandant of the S.D.F.), and applications should be addressed through the normal channels. Full details of terms and conditions of service may be obtained by direct application to H.M. Tps. Sudan.

Applications must normally be unexpired and between 25 and 35 years of age. Accommodation for married officers is very limited.

CONTRACT OF SERVICE.

Officers appointed to the post-war establishment will be offered contracts of service in the Sudan Government. Normally the term of service will be for 2 years. 1. The recent increase in the number of offences involving fraud and dishonesty by officers is causing serious concern. Many officers now-a-days are faced with considerable temptation owing to the opportunities which exist for taking large sums of money by dishonest means. Owing to the dislocation in administration caused by release it is sometimes difficult for an adequate degree of supervision to be exercised. Also many cases of carelessly kept or deliberately falsified accounts are now coming to light for the first time when the officers responsible for them are handing over preparatory to going on release.

2. It cannot be too strongly emphasized that an officer in the Army is in a position of trust, and an officer who is guilty of an offence involving fraud or dishonesty deserves a heavier punishment than a soldier convicted of a similar offence, since he has abused in a greater degree the particular trust placed upon him and has also in many cases disgraced the Service in the eyes of the civil population. These offences are criminal, and courts martial will bear in mind when considering sentence that a purely military punishment such as cashiering or dismissal may be quite inadequate to meet the case. An officer who is tempted to commit a fraud such as selling or illegally disposing of Government property, or falsifying accounts, should realize that he is making himself liable to a long term of Penal Servitude or Imprisonment, which may wreck the whole of his future life.

3. Commanding officers will bear in mind the increased opportunities for fraud which now exist and insist on a tighter supervision of Government property and accounts. Before signing a clearance certificate for an officer going on release they will carry out adequate investigations and if any illegal transactions are brought to light they will hold the officer concerned for enquiry and apply to the appropriate authorities for a report on disciplinary grounds.

REPORT INSTRUCTIONS NO. 1

12 November 1945

The following instructions are circulated for guidance of units in reporting casualties concerning officers' appointments, promotions and grants of war substantive ranks (hereafter referred to as MS casualties).

All such casualties will in future be reported on A.F. W301CA and NO OTHER TYPE OF CASUALTY will be reported on A.F. W301CA which reports MS casualties. Postings, claims for additional pay, etc, will be reported separately.

It is, however, particularly to be understood that on no account must there be any delay in reporting an officers' movement, i.e., the actual despatch on posting from one unit to another, though there may be delay in obtaining authorities for appointments, etc.

1. APPOINTMENTS

- (a) (i) All appointments and relinquishments of appointment which are normally published in the MS Lists issued as an appendix to GRCs, must, in any circumstances whatsoever, be reported to the HQ which controls such appointments, and A.F. W301CA should not be submitted until authority has been given. Additional pay derived from these appointments, command pay (in the case of Lt Coln's commands) 2nd in command pay (in the case of Majors entitled thereto) and adjutants' pay, should NOT be claimed until the appropriate casualty has been published in the MS Lists issued as an appendix to GRCs.

Despatching units will report relinquishments wef date S.O.S., and a copy of A.P. W3010A will be taken personally by the officer concerned to hand to his new unit on arrival; the new unit must ensure that date of assumption reported is not earlier than either :-

- (a) date of relinquishment in former unit, or
(b) date of relinquishment by the outgoing officer who is being replaced.

(11) The despatching unit need make no reference on A.F. W301CA to the new appointment to be assumed. The receiving unit need make no reference on A.F. W301CA to the former appointment held. IT IS EMPHASISED THAT A.F. W301CA ARE REQUIRED FROM ALL UNITS CONCERNED.

(a) Upgrading of command, staff, extra-regimental and intelligence appointments are to be reported as such, and NOT as regimental promotions.

2. PROMOTIONS.

(a) Officers can only be promoted to fill vacancies in the authorised War Establishment of the unit on whose posted strength they are held. Promotions are NOT admissible for officers who are held on X Lists (other than X (1) List).

(b) Where Higher Formation authority is required for a promotion, the instructions given in para 2 above regarding appointments will be applied and observed.

(c) Promotions to paid acting rank or regants of temporary rank, are in every case dependent on the rank being held on that accession for a minimum of 22 clear days. For periods of 21 days or less, unpaid acting rank only is admissible.

(d) Where a promotion has been made vice an officer who has proceeded on LIAP, and during his absence, the temporary incumbent is absorbed in a vacancy in war establishment in the rank which he is holding by virtue of his LIAP promotion, no further promotion in rank is necessary, merely because the promotion has become permanent one. No further A.F. W301CA will be rendered, but GMR 2nd Echelon will be advised of the situation by letter.

3. GRANTS ON TEMPORARY AND WAR SUBSTITUTIVE RANK.

(a) When paid acting rank is held continuously for the period necessary to qualify the holder for the grant of temporary (and war substitutive) rank, the period is calculated in calendar months, except as stated in sub-para (c) below.

(b) When paid rank is held during two or more broken periods, such periods are cumulative. Grant of temporary (and war substitutive) rank is made waf 92nd in these cases (or waf 163rd day in the cases of colonels and brigadiers).

(c) Periods of paid acting rank retained under the provisions of GPO 706 of 1944, para 5 (d) are reckonable towards grant of temporary (and war substitutive) rank.

(d) Periods of unpaid acting rank are NOT reckonable towards grant of temporary rank.

- (e) Grant of temporary rank is made to C/M/AIN officers after paid acting rank has been held for 181 days, waf 182nd day.
- (f) Where 2/Lieutants are not recommended for promotion to the war substantive rank of Lieut after six months' commissioned service, units MUST ensure that GRC 2nd Echelon is so notified.
- (g) Where promotion of 2/Lieutants to the war substantive rank of Lieut is claimed by virtue of other rank service, full details of such service, and the dates between which different ranks were held, must be stated.

4. LLAF.

Separate instructions are being issued in GRCs, concerning the procedure to be adopted when an officer who holds a command, staff, etc, appointment proceeds on LLAF. Meantime, the foregoing rules will apply. When separate instructions are issued, they will be read in conjunction with this instruction, and where they conflict, GRCs will be copy laid with.
