Following letter No. 9106/02 dated 26.Oct.45. for onward transmission, as per law regulations, herewith attached circular from War Ministry-General Directorate, Recruiting, Non-Commissioned officers and troops No. 40049 dated 2.Dec.45., that substitutes the instructions contained in the previous circular, of even reference dated 13.Oct.45.

Subject: Absent strength

Owing to a probable disbandment of the 802 Re-organisation Center, Orvieto the 807 transit camp or provacening and also the transit camps of all the administrative divisions contained in the circular 1004 dated 18-10-45 and in the others will be amended as follows:-

- a) All the militaries who are in Unit's strength, and also for any reason temporary except - on leave of any kind, including sick leave superior to 14 days - absentees without leave. Who for some reasons have not yet been reported, the unit interested being always obliged to report them to the competent authority - and for other reasons) are absent from their effective duty for a period superior to 30 days, will be passed from the effective strength of the same Units to the absent strength of the relative recruiting centers (normal and subsidiary) or the military districts of residence.

Exactly:

- b) In the absent strength of the recruiting centers, the militaries pertaining to units under territorial H.Q., Infantry divisions, central military Schools Command, I.S. Divisions, units under the Ministry of War;

With the exception only of:

University students allowed to have a three month leave subject to renewals; according to circular 12025/R dated 30-7-45, who have to be taken in the absent strength of the relative district at the time of leave. The admitted in hospitals or convalescent-homes (see para 5).

- c) In the absent strength of the residence district all the others (Administrative Divisions and units already under disbanded Divisions 203-210-220, railways groups, reorganisation: camp at Orvieto and Units under the disbanded civilian Command 212, notifying the recruiting center for onward transmission to the interested District; of records duly vised, (the militaries pertaining to the a/h units at present in the absent strength of the recruiting Centers will soon be taken in the absent strength of the relative districts).

The a/h militaries will be listed in a special roll "Absent strength" supplied with an alphabetical index, kept at the recruiting centers and residence districts.

Temporary exempt - on leave of any kind, including sick leaves superior to 14 days - absentees without leave. Who for some reasons have not been reported, the unit interested seeing always obliged to report them to the competent authority - and for other reasons) are absent from their effective duty for a period superior to 30 days, may be released from the effective strength of the same units to the absent strength of the selective recruiting centers (normal and subsidiary) of the Military Districts of residence.

Exactly:

- a) In the absent strength of the recruiting centers, the militaries pertaining to units under Territorial Service, Infantry Divisions, Cavalry of Artillery Schools Command, I.S. Divisions, units under the Ministry of War;

- With the exception only of:
- Universities students allowed to have a three month leave subject to renew; according to circular L202b/R dated 30-7-45, who have to be taken in the absent strength of the relative district at the time of leave.
- The admitted in hospitals or convalescent-homes (see para 5).

- b) In the absent strength of the residence division all the others (Administrative Divisions and units already under disbanded Divisions 200-210-220, railways groups, reorganisation camp at Oviedo and Units under the disbanded Italian Command 212, notifying the recruiting center for onward transmission to the interested District of records duly filed, (the militaries pertaining to the a/n units at present in the absent strength of the recruiting Centers will soon be taken in the absent strength of the relative districts).
- The a/n militaries will be listed in a special roll "Absent Strength" supplied with an alphabetical Index, kept at the recruiting centers and residence districts.
- 2) The militaries mentioned in para a), after 30 days permanence in the "Absent Strength" of the recruiting center, none remaining the absence, will also be passed, from the interested recruiting center, to the "Absent Strength" of the residence district, where will also be forwarded the relative records duly used.
- 3) When militaries listed in the "Absent Strength" both of the recruiting center and residence districts - must be on ~~date~~ again, - except those from Sardinia (see para 3) - they have to see:
- if they were attached to units under the residence districts which the disbanded Italian Command 212 or (will assign them in accordance those ones under disbanded Divisions (I.C. 200-210-220 and re-organisation camp, Oviedo, railways groups)

b) If attached to units under territorial H.Q. Twenty Divisions, Central Training Schools, I.S. Divisions, units under the Ministry of War.

The corps or units to which they were attached before ~~that~~ were taken in the "Absent Strength" of the recruiting centers or residence districts if taken by them after 20 day absence, or because they were university students or admitted in hospitals.

Except the members of

the mainland, who will go

to their residence districts.

In the meanwhile:

For the militiamen named in the above para a):

The residence districts:

Will forward to their territorial Mil. H.Q. by the 1st, 20th and 20th of each month, stating (with necessity date, birth, rank, unit, classification etc.) of the militiamen who will cease to be in "absent Strength" in the next ten days.

Successively they will communicate to the said command that the militiamen who have called in have been sent to their destination.

The territorial Mil. H.Q. which will use the said militiamen as a replacement of organic deficiencies to the units under its jurisdiction, - will take care of the preventive designation of the noted militiamen, informing immediately the districts, so that these will be able to send the militiamen, at the time of their calling in, to the units to which they have been assigned. 450

Will notify the General Staff the eventual exonerances.

The arbitrary absentees, in any way recuperated, will soon be notified by the territorial Mil. H.Q. for the prompt designation to the units; in the meanwhile will temporary stay at the districts and will be administered by the temporary Unit and supplied with rations for transit personnel for duty purposes.

The militiamen, notified by the General Staff as not needed by the territorial H.Q., will remain in the absent strength and left at their residence until their designation is communicated.

For the militiamen mentioned at para b):

The H.Q. of his Unit are authorized to do equal distribution

In the meanwhile:

Not the militiamen mentioned in the above para (a);

The regiments, units:

Will return to their tents until 11th, by the 1st, 10th and 20th of each month, statemente (with necessary date; year of birth, rank, unit, organization etc.) of the militiamen who will cease to be in "Absent Strength" in the next ten days.

Successively they will return to the said command that the militiamen who have called in have been sent to their destination.

The territorial militia U.S.A. Which will use the said militia as a replacement of organic detachments to the units under its jurisdiction, - will take care of the preventive assignation of the noted militiamen, informing immediately the districts, so that these will be able to send the militiamen, at the time of their calling in, to the limits to which they have been assigned; U.S.A

Will notify the General Staff the eventual exuberances.

The arbitrary absentees, in any way recuperated, will soon be notified by the territorial militia U.S.A. for the prompt assignation to the units; in the meanwhile will temporary stay at the districts and will be administered by the temporary Unit and supplied with rations for combat personnel for duty purposes.

The militiamen, listed by the General Staff as not needed by the territorial U.S.A., will remain in the agent strength and stay at their residence until their assignation is communicated.

For the militiamen mentioned at para (a):

The U.S. offices Units are authorized to do equal distribution in their competence every time, with the recovery of the absent strength, the organics of the dependent units date exceeded; will notify the General Staff the eventual embarras not engageable.

The same militiamen, engaged in the agent's strength, living in Sardinia, and those considered cured after more than 60 days in hospitals in Sardinia, ceasing from absent strength, instead of collating in it, the convenience corps, it will be placed in the mainland, will be engaged to replace the organics assignments of those on the same limit, in accordance with territorial officer, Sardinia.

The disposition of the hospitals or convalescent home will inform the provosting center or entrenched district, for subsequent records movements, the unit and the place on the island where the militiaman has been sent.

the recruiting centers and districts (excluding the absent strength of absenees who must go to their provenance units.) from units displaced in Sardinia, will not go back to their provenance unit at the time of the census of the absent strength. They will, on the contrary engaged by the Parr. Mil. N... as stated in para 3.a)

It is absolutely indispensable that:

The recruiting centers or military districts interested take care of notifying at once, through Territorial Commands or U.s. in stations to all the militars go must go back to duty, where they must call in.

It is also necessary that corps and units specify on leave warrants or other documents, given to the militars who are absent the recruiting center and U.s. by which the militar's unit depends.

The provenance districts and recruiting centers will notify at once the destination of each militar:

- To the unit to which he is assigned,
- To the recruiting center of the assigned Unit, transmitting there the records duly vised.

5) Militars admitted in hospital or convalescent-homes will be kept in the effective strength of their units for the first 30 days - see para 11 No. 3 circular 220500/77 Gabinetto - dated 14 Sept. 45 - afterwards Units will take them in the "absent Strength" of the Military district where the militar is admitted, and to his recruiting center so that it provides to the onward transmission of records, vised, to the district.

The hospital direction or military convalescent home, which after 60 days, takes the militar in the hospital or convalescent home absent strength the militar has been taken.

The militar/who must be on duty after 30 days in hospital will be sent by the hospital which has judged him to be in good health to the residence district, if the militar pertains to the category mentioned in para 3 a) (those who are in hospital in Sardinia will be on the contrary, assigned to units on the island, in accordance with the territorial office), to the provenance units of the militar pertaining to the category mentioned in para 3 b), inclosing - for the relative records - the militar's district in which has been strength the militar was taken (with exception to the militars, pertaining to units detached in Sardinia, admitted in hospitals of the continent or living on the same island, who will be sent to the residence district and engaged in the garrisoned mil. E.).

4) The recruiting center and G.U. by which the militer's unit depends
 The recruitment of each militer's unit depends the

- To the unit to which he is assigned,
- To the recruiting center of the assigned unit, transmitting them the records dulyvised.

5) Militer admitted in hospital or convalescent-homes will be kept in the effective strength of their unit for the first 60 days, including eventual leave of 14 days - see para II No. 3 circular 17000/71 Cabinet - dated 14 Sept. 45. Afterwards units will take them in the absent category of the Military district where the militer is admitted, and to his recruiting center so that it provides to the command transmission of records, vised, to the district.

The hospital (3) rection or military convalescent home, which after 60 days, takes the militer in the hospital or convalescent home, absent strength the militer has been taken.

The militer who must be on duty after 60 days in hospital will be sent by the hospital which has judged him to be in good health:

- to the residence district, if the militer pertains to the category mentioned in para 3 (a) (those who are in hospital in Sardinia will on the contrary, assigned to units on the island, in accordance with the territorial office);
- to the provenience units if the militer pertains to the category mentioned in para 3 (b), informing - for the selective records - the military district in which absent strength the militer was taken (with exception to the militer, pertaining to units detached in Sardinia, admitted in hospitals of the mainland or living on the same mainland, who will be sent to the residence district and enregistered by the territorial unit, G.W.).

For explanation of what is said in the mentioned cabinet circular about leaves for the Italian Military personnel (No. 220000 para II No. 3) it is specified that the granting of a long sick leave, superior to 14 days, causes the ceasing of the unit effective strength and the taking over in the absent strength of respective residence district to start from the date of beginning the same leave, when between sick leave and permanence in hospital are spent more than 30 days of absence of absence of the militer from the unit.

6) Militer mobilized or kept in mentioned in the above paragraphs, is recognized by the competent authority authorities, permanently fit for conditional or limited service or will be in future judged fit only for sedentary service and are or must be taken in the absent strength, instead of this condition must be, according to

Cases, by units, hospitals, recruiting centers or districts, released because unfit without displacing the person, settling by correspondence eventual matters, with the recruiting center or military court to specify the militiamen's position.

"The branch that deals with the discharge, will notify the recruiting centers for onward transmission, with up to date registrations documents to the authorized districts.

It is reminded that :

- a) the soldier on convalescent leave, for illness caused while on duty cannot be released if the legal medical intercourse is not completed;
 - b) the soldiers conscripted or held on the absent strength that were recognized classified for a certain period, temporarily suitable, cease from the absent strength and being still on the ability period, must be sent on convalescent leave, until the period expires.
 - c) those that are still detailed with, military duties that were classified temporarily or permanently, suitable to conditional or restricted duties, or will only be suitable in the future as graded men, will have to return to the position of temporarily released (visible to be called) with restoration of registered documents, issued at the recruiting centers, in care of the branch that has them on strength.
 - d) Soldiers from the absent strength must not be sent to corps or units, belonging to refugee age groups or in charge of release.
- The branches that have these soldiers on their recruitment rolls in military districts of residence must provide to their release in their country.
- e) Those soldiers also on special training rolls of the "Absent Strength" branch separately as in No. 1) must not be shown in the periodical effective strength of the recruiting center or districts, making exception for the 3 monthly visitation of the effective strength in which the mentioned soldiers must be distinguished separately.
 - f) For those soldiers on special nominal rolls "Absent Strength" who are entitled to economic treatment will be kept in separate books pending records and may sheets by the same recruiting center or districts, districts that has them in nominal rolls. It is understood that those soldiers are not entitled to food rations.
 - g) To the registered soldiers concerned, after the regarding changes, to the registration be again extraordinary issued without

b) The soldiers conscripted or held on the absent strength that were recognized classified for a certain period, temporarily suitable, cause from the absent strength and being still on the ability period, must be sent on convalescent leave, until the period expires.

c) Those that are still detailed with military forces that were classified temporarily or permanently, suitable to conditional or restricted duties, or will only be suitable in the future as graded men, will have to return to the position of temporarily released (unable to be called) with restoration of registered documents, engaged at the recruiting centers, in care of the branch that has them on strength.

d) Soldiers from the absent strength must not be sent to corps or units, belonging to service age groups or in course of release.

The branches that have these soldiers on their absent strength OR military districts of residence must provide to their release in their country.

e) Those soldiers also on special nominal rolls of the "Absent Strength," marked separately as An No. 1, must not be shown in the periodical effective strengths of the recruiting center or districts, making an exception for the 3 monthly situation of the effective strength in which the mentioned soldiers must be distinguished separately.

f) For those soldiers on special nominal rolls "Absent Strength" who are entitled to economic treatment will be kept in separate books/pic records and pay sheets by the same recruiting centers or military districts that has them in nominal rolls. It is understood that these soldiers are not entitled to food rations.

g) To the registered soldiers concerned, after the regarding changes, to the position he is in (extraordinary leave without pay, convalescent leave, 6 months discharge, desertion, etc.) will be applied the following changes:

- units detached in Berlin, residing in the mainland;
- unit of railroad groups,
- University students sent on three months leave renewable (circular of 30. July. 1945);
- Those sent on convalescent leave of 14 days duration and pass a period of 30 days at the hospital;
- being in the hospital over 60 days;
- already 90 days in the absent strength from recruiting centers;

DESCRIPTION C)

Cessions from the absent strength the soldiers return to their pertaining units as follows:

- Those that already belong to the detached units in mainland and which are assigned to their district of residence and will be instructed in description 3); -
- those already belonging to units and detached in the mainland which reside in Sardinia (will go to the Sardinia districts and will be assigned upon determination of the new offices of Sardinia),
- those dismissed and cured after 60 days that have been in the hospital in Sardinia (will be assigned directly by the Directorate of the Hospital upon determination of Terr. offices in Sardinia).

Description 1)

- leaving those absent strays) they must go to their district of residence, which will assign them to detached units in the Terr. jurisdiction by determination of the same Terr. command;
- those already belonging to the units will continue or already disbanded;

Description 2)

- those belonging to the disbanded units residing in the mainland;
- those belonging to units of the designation of residing in Sardinia;

Description 3)

- will be sent directly by order of the directorate of the hospital to their pertaining units or those belonging to units of description 3)
- make the exceptions taken for soldiers in Sardinia hospitals;
- all the others will be sent to their district of residence.

It has also been ordered the substitution of the guard and instructions in regard of arms, so that no other mistake will be made again.

Subject:- Discharge of Small-Arms.

To : r- Comando Territoriale, Palermo.

1. It is understood that during the Bandit-attack on Palermo Radio Station on the night of 1 March 46, the sentries at the Autocentro were ordered to fire "in the direction of Radio Station" by Ten. CASSONI (officer of the day).

2. The Radio Station is situated approx 1 Km. from the Autocentro.

3. As you are no doubt aware, such unauthorised action is completely contrary to Article 254 of "NORME PER IL SERVIZIO DI PRESIDIO".

4. In ordering those sentries to fire this Officer was endangering the lives of some hundreds of civilians living in that area.

5. As it is, this particular incident had a very bad effect on the morale of the people of Palermo, and caused a great deal of alarm and despondency amongst them.

6. It is therefore requested that (a) severe disciplinary action be taken against this officer for ordering this indiscriminate shooting. (b) All C.n C. Units are issued with new "Standing-Orders for Sentries", - including an order clearly laying-down when fire-arms will be discharged.

7. Please inform this Unit (for onward transmission to H.Q. M.M.I.A.) what disciplinary action is taken against the officer concerned.
