SUBJECT : Pay ex Italian POW 2nd Lt CALABRESE, Salvatore.

TO : Prisoner of War Accounts Office, Middle East Forces.

1. Attached is letter and copy of statement of accounts received at this HQ from the above named Italian Army Cooperator.

2. He states that his credit at the time of signing statement of cooperation in June 1944 was nil and that the credit stated on attached copy of his statement of accounts has all been accumulated during his service as a cooperator.

The latter fact is not however specifically stated on his statement of accounts as issued by O.I/c P.O.W. Accounts Office M.E.F. as a result of which the Ministry of War say that they will only pay him his credit (£8.17.0d) at the rate of 72 Lire to the Pound.

3. It is appreciated that the form in which individual Pay Statements are handed to all PWs prior to repatriation cannot be altered but it is thought that if you would state that a/m PWs credit Balance was NIL on beginning cooperation, the Italian Authorities might pay him at the higher rate.
