Ref. your letter VGP/15/60 dated 7. Jan. and attached passes for above named Italian military personnel.

1. Letter under reference reached this H.Q. on 28. Jan. 46, and since attached passes were only valid until 31. Jan. 46. they were unable to be used.
2. In the absence of an officer at this H.Q. at the time these passes were amended to expire on 1. Mch. 46 and forwarded to 11 Territorial H.Q. This action was incorrect and the passes were recalled by this H.Q.
3. In view of the extremely slow postal service between N. Italy and Sicily and slow transport facilities for Italian military personnel, can the attached passes be made out to allow 7 weeks from the date of issue to the expiring date. This would cater for:
  - a) Passes being 2 weeks in post.
  - b) 1 weeks travelling for personnel proceeding to Venezia Giulia
  - c) 4 weeks liberation leave.
4. It would be appreciated if this matter is given prompt attention since these soldiers have been waiting for a period of over 2 months for these passes.
