1. The disposal to the Italian Government through Azienda Rilievo Alienazione Residuati, of material of Allied, Italian and enemy origin located on the island of Pantelleria has been agreed by A.F.H.Q.
2. 6 copies of quantitative receipts will be compiled in respect of the material and 5 copies forwarded to this Branch for onward transmission to A.F.H.Q. G-5 Section, who in turn will transmit them to Q "CEMS" G.H.Q. Material of British, American, Italian and enemy origin will be listed on separate receipts.
3. This material is released for use in the civil rehabilitation of Pantelleria and any material which is of a war like nature will be rendered innocuous and reduced to scrap and the resultant salvage used for civil rehabilitation purposes.
4. Any monies which have been accrued as a result of previous transactions should be paid into the Banca d'Italia to the credit of A.F.A., Rome, No 1 Account. Notification of any such payments should be made to this Branch.
5. Azienda Rilievo Alienazione Residuati has been notified of this release and will name a nominee who will sign receipts on their behalf on the island of Pantelleria. Immediately the name is to hand you will be notified.
