1. The Direzione Commissariato, on receipt of such reports from Port Detachments or OSC Depots will, by arrangement with the MMIA Sector Liaison Officer concerned, convene an Analysis Commission to examine and adjudicate upon the supplies in question. Analysis Commission will comprise:-

An officer representative of MMIA.  
An Italian officer representing the Direzione Commissariato.  
An Italian officer qualified as a chemist or food analyst.

Where necessary an additional independent analyst's report may be obtained.

2. Analysis Commissions will record facts and record action taken, in accordance with the Analysis Report, proforma for which is attached at Appendix 'B'. This report is required in sextuplicate, copies disposed:-  
(one) 1 copy retained by MMIA Sector Liaison Officer,  
(one) 1 copy retained by the concerned Direzione Commissariato,  
(Four) 4 copies forwarded to H.Q. MMIA.

3. Action recommended by Analysis Commission, vide para II of the Analysis Report, may be put into effect forthwith without awaiting confirmation by H.Q. MMIA. In cases where immediate destruction is decided upon, the Destruction Certificate forming part of Appendix 'B' will be completed before the Analysis Report is sent forward.

4. After endorsement of Analysis Reports by H.Q. MMIA 2 copies will be disposed as follows:-  
One (1) copy to the Italian Ministry of War,  
One (1) copy to the Direzione Commissariato,  
(Three MMIA Sector 10 end will be used as a credit voucher to stock record of depot concerned).  
One (1) copy retained by H.Q. MMIA.

An Italian officer qualified as a chemist or food analyst may be obtained.

2. Analysis Commissions will record facts and record section taken, in accordance with the analysis report, proforma for which is attached at appendix 'B'.  
This report is required in sextuplicate, copies disposed:-

- (one) 1 copy retained by ~~UNIA~~ Sector Liaison Officer,
- (one) 1 copy retained by the concerned Direzione Commissariato,
- (four) 4 copies forwarded to ~~UNIA~~ UNIA.

3. Action recommended by analysis Commission, vide para II of the Analysis Report, may be put into effect forthwith without awaiting confirmation by ~~UNIA~~ UNIA.

In cases where immediate destruction is decided upon, the destruction Certificate forming part of Appendix 'B', will be completed before the Analysis Report is sent forward.

4. After endorsement of analysis reports by ~~UNIA~~ UNIA, copies will be disposed as follows:-

- One (1) copy to the Italian Ministry of War,
- One (1) copy to the Divisione Commissariato,  
(Through ~~UNIA~~ Sector LO and will be used as a credit voucher to stock record of depot concerned).
- One (1) copy retained by ~~UNIA~~ UNIA.
- One (1) copy to Chief Accountant, (LCC) (if Italian Government ie allowed credit)

5. Destruction of foodstuffs as a result of the recommendations of Analysis Commissions will be witnessed by an ~~UNIA~~ Sector Liaison Officer, and Destruction Certificate normally the ~~UNIA~~ Sector Liaison Officer concerned, completed accordingly.

6. In cases where it is a matter of urgent necessity to destroy foodstuffs to ensure the safe keeping of other commodities, or in cases where destruction is so urgently required that the analysis Commission procedure is impracticable Officers Commanding Italian Army Depots will so inform the ~~UNIA~~ Sector Liaison Officer concerned. The latter will authorize and witness any such destruction and will ensure that analysis Reports and destruction Certificates are completed as to relevant entries and disposed as stated in para 4 above. The OC Italian Army Depot will submit a report in writing to the Direzione Commissariato, giving the full circumstances.

7. Foodstuffs found unfit for consumption in Italian Army units and formations will normally be returned to Distribution Depots for replacement in kind. Thereafter they will be dealt with by the concerned Distribution Depot in accordance with these instructions.
  8. Foodstuffs unfit for human consumption may be suitable for animal consumption or may contain recoverable fats or other recoverable by-products or components. Analysis Commissions will pay particular regard to this point and will recommend disposal to ensure the maximum benefit accrues to Italian and Allied Armed Forces.
  9. In NO instance will foodstuffs found unfit for human consumption be replaced in kind to the Italian Armed Forces.
  10. The foregoing instructions become effective immediately and you are requested to issue your own instructions accordingly without delay, regarding a copy to this Headquarters for information.
