This is to inform you that I have been approached by Mr. Lawrence Hughes, the present administrator of Lord Bridport's estate, the Duchy of Bronte, with regard to the insufficient allocation of petrol for the running of his car, and hence for looking after the affairs of such a large estate. He tells me he has an allocation of 40 litres per month from Italian sources, and adds that it is impossible to efficiently administer Lord Bridport's property with a car, which for most of the time cannot be used for lack of petrol.

I do not know whether you are in a position to help Mr. Hughes in his difficulties, and should to hear from you on this point. Should you require an authorisation from high quarters, I dare say I will have no difficulty in obtaining same from H.M. Government in London, as Lord Bridport is at the Admiralty (a naval officer I believe) and the affairs of the Duchy have - for various reasons, touching on British interests - been the concern of our Government.
