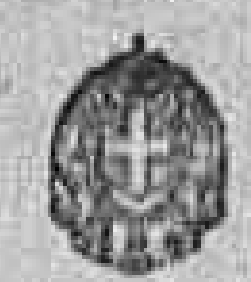

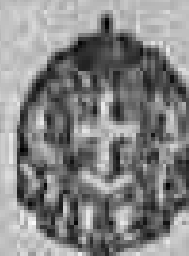

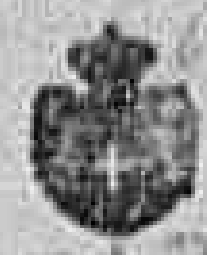

1. With reference to GPO letter 1076/47-1 Serial 6026, dated 7 Jan 47, notifying the disbandment of your unit, your attention is directed to GPO 683/43 dated 17 Dec 43 as amended by GPO 1342/45 dated 7 Dec 45 and GPO 588/46 dated 23 Aug 46, which indicates the action to be taken by you in connection with the disposal of correspondence addressed to personnel now serving with your unit, and which may come to hand in the British Army Postal Service after your unit has been disbanded. A copy of the GPO as amended is connected for ready reference.

2. A redirection section is attached to the British Army GPO to meet the requirements of the GPO. In order that it may function to the best advantage to all concerned, compliance with the GPO and with the following points not specifically covered therein is essential:-

(a) The nominal rolls and, where appropriate, the unit representative, should be despatched in time to reach the British Army GPO VILLAGE at least two clear days before the date of disbandment. Unless this is done continuity of postal services cannot be provided. If the future addresses are not all known when the nominal rolls are despatched, supplementary details can be sent later by post. Postal Address Redirection Card, IP 120420, should not be used for this purpose.

(b) In addition to the particulars of personnel serving with the unit at the date of disbandment the nominal rolls should include full particulars with new addresses of all personnel who left the unit within the previous month. This should include personnel returning to U.K. together with their addresses there. If the address in U.K. is unknown the indicator "Returned UK release" or "Returned UK Pythons" etc., should appear.

(c) It will be seen that the GPO requires the Post Orderly to be attached to 15 Base APC for a period not exceeding six weeks. The selection for this duty of an individual with less than six weeks to serve within the Command will prejudice speedily and accurate redirection of the unit mail. You are requested, therefore, to ensure that the representative despatched to 15 Base APC is not due for Pythons or Release within six weeks and is not under consideration for compassionate posting etc.

(d) It is not intended to continue redirection beyond two months from the date of disbandment and it is, therefore, imperative that you ensure that all pending action in accordance with para. 4 of the GPO, at the expiry of two months any correspondence still received for the old address will be returned to the senders.

3. Should the major portion of your unit be re-posted to another unit in the Command, you may consider it more desirable to have all mail for your present unit

disposal of correspondence addressed to personnel now serving with your unit, and which may come to hand in the British Army Postal Service after your unit has been disbanded. A copy of the GPO as amended is connected for ready reference.

2. A redirection section is attached to the British Base APO to meet the requirements of the GPO. In order that it may function to the best advantage to all concerned, compliance with the GPO and with the following points not specifically covered therein is essential:-

(a) The nominal rolls and, where appropriate, the unit representative, should be despatched in time to reach the British Base APO VILLAGE at least two clear days before the date of disbandment. Unless this is done continuity of postal services cannot be provided. (b) In addition to the particulars of personnel serving with the unit at the date of disbandment the nominal rolls should include full particulars with new addresses of all personnel who left the unit within the previous month. This should include personnel returning to U.K. together with their addresses there. If the address in U.K. is unknown the indicator "Returned in release" or "Returned UK Pythons" etc., should appear.

(c) It will be seen that the GPO requires the Post Orderly to be attached to 15 Base APO for a period not exceeding six weeks. The selection for this duty of an individual with long then six weeks to serve within the Command will prejudice speedily and accurate redirection of the unit mail. You are requested, therefore, to ensure that the representative despatched to 15 Base APO is not due for Pythons or Release within six weeks and is not under consideration for commensurate posting etc.

(d) It is not intended to continue redirection beyond two months from the date of disbandment and it is, therefore, imperative that you ensure that all ranks take action in accordance with para. 4 of the GPO.
