Further to my letter 11 R.P. dated 22 May, and now that are over the duties for public order during the electoral campaign, I will inform you that:

- 1.- the behaviour of all the Troops in Sicily in those difficult political times can be judge as the best.
I can state that everybody, apart their own political ideas, have done their duty as citizens and soldiers, aware of the highest interest of the country.
- 2.- Reference the C.A.R. (I had not excluded the possibility of individual or party absence) I can state that (notwithstanding the Public order longer than foreseen), the absents without leave are only 33 in a strength of 2300 men, and 10 of them are again back.
