1. In answer to a communication made to G.H.Q. by this H.Q. the following answer which is self explanatory has been received and is forwarded for your information :

"It is agreed that it is undesirable for officers of M.I.A. to sit as members of British Military Courts trying Italian subjects on war crimes charges. Instructions will accordingly be issued to Convening Officers to refrain from detailing such officers for this duty.

It is not felt that there should be any objection however to officers of M.I.A. sitting as members of courts where the accused are solely German or Austrian subjects, nor to them appearing as defending officers when the accused are Italians."

2. Instructions accordingly have been issued by G.H.Q. to Rear H.Q. XIII Corps and H.Q. 3 District.

- 4°- MARZUCCHI Mario father Camillo, mother Tamheri Anita, born in Campiglia Marittima on 24 August 1898, wanted as murderer of a British Captain. - Unfindable.
- 5°- ZAMBONI Giorgio father Genserico, mother Media Innocenza, born in Bologna on 1 Nove. 1909; ex captain of the Republican guards, O.C. 2nd Coy O.P. in Andria. Damned to death by the Special Grand Jury of Rovigo with judgment on 5.12.'45, being responsible of the partisans slaughter in Villamargana (Rovigo). Unfindable.

I have interrogated the a/n and have the following observations to make.

1. Attached at Appendix "A" is a chronological-list of this Officers' movements since the time of his commission in 1938.

2. From this it will be seen that between Dec.42 and Apr. 43, he was actually stationed at AVERSA (NAPLES).

3. I have checked all his documents, and amongst them have found sufficient evidence (including pay-slips issued to him at AVERSA in Dec.42 and Jan.43) to substantiate his movements.

4. I am satisfied that this officer has not at any time been stationed with the Porto Farina Detachment at BIZZERTA.
