

The attention of all units of the Italian civilian labor force is directed to the terms of Allied Force Headquarters Circular Instruction No. 5 dated Larch, 1945, which are reproduced hereunder.

1. GENERAL:

a. Following the established policy of the Italian Government in favor of those residing in Italy: Industrial Bonus, Dismissal Bonus and Annual Leave will be granted to Italian civilian employees of the Allied Forces for each month of completed service or fraction thereof. (See Jornograph No below). Furthermore, they will be granted six (6) paid holidays a year.

b. Current instructions or publications in contact with this memorandum are hereto attached.

c. This instruction will be effective from the date of publication. Bonuses and annual leave will be computed retroactive to 1 January, 1945, or the date of enrollment, whichever is later, but will not apply to personnel who have been discharged from employment before the publication of this instruction.

d. Only those Italian civilians employed by the allied forces on a permanent or contract basis are entitled to the benefits under this directive:

- (1) Permanent employees are those persons employed for ~~United Nations~~ but not less than 1 year, for seasonal work, or for ~~United Nations~~ but indefinite duration.
- (2) Seasonal employees are those persons employed for ~~United Nations~~ but not less than 1 year, for seasonal work, or for ~~United Nations~~ but indefinite duration.

2. CHRISTMAS BONUS: A Christmas Bonus will be paid to Italian civilians employed on a permanent or contract basis, each having to account at the rate of two days pay per month, to be paid on the normal day unless otherwise directed or if absent, whichever shall occur first.

The amount of the bonus for each employee will be two days' current basic pay and cost of living bonuses for each completed month of continuous service during the year of 1945 with the present employing unit or the predecessor thereof.

For the purpose of this computation all Italian Civilian employees in employ as of 20 December 1945 will be deemed to be continuing in employment for the balance of one month. December.





1. It has now been decided that in all cases where units require to employ civilians under categories Groups I and II and above i.e., application must be made for an increase to unit A accordingly, and this will in due course be adjudicated upon by A Committee at AFN.

5. Returns from units will reach this N. by 7 Oct 45 on the standard proforma as attached, and 12 copies will be required.

6. The filing of applications with this N. for amendment to A to include civilian personnel, will entitle units, to whom authority for employment of such civilians has already been given by Labour Branch of this N., to continue their employment until such time as the A Committee has adjudicated upon the application.

7. In the case of units who do not submit application for amendment of A as above, authority to continue to employ civilians will cease with effect from 10 Oct 45.

8. Proposals will be subjected to rigid scrutiny by AFN. Units must support their proposals with detailed evidence. The question should first be considered whether an alternative solution exists, e.g., application for allocation from staff and services pool, amalgamation of forces to reduce overall man staff required, etc.

9. All previous instructions issued by this N. in respect of these matters are hereby cancelled.
