The attention of all units employing civilian labour is directed to the terms of Allied Force Headquarters Administrative Memorandum No. 5 dated 4 March, 1946, which are reprinted hereunder.

1. General:

a. Pursuant to the established policy of keeping conditions of employment and wages equal for Allied Force employees in step with those prevailing in Italian industry a Christmas Bonus, Dismissal Bonus and Paid Annual Leave will be granted to Italian civilian employees of the Allied Forces for each month of completed service or fraction thereof. (See paragraph 5b below). Furthermore, they will be granted six (6) paid holidays a year.

b. Previous instructions or publications in conflict with this Memorandum are hereby rescinded.

c. This Memorandum will be effective from the date of publication. Bonuses and annual leave with pay provided by this directive will be computed retroactive to 1 January, 1946, or the date of employment, whichever is later, but will not apply to personnel who have been discharged from employment before the publication of this Memorandum.

d. Only those Italian civilians employed by the Allied Forces on a permanent or semi-permanent basis are entitled to the benefits under this directive:

- (1) Permanent employees are those persons regularly employed on a permanent basis or for a lengthy indefinite period of time.
- (2) Semi-permanent employees are those persons employed for limited periods of time not less than 1 week, for seasonal work, or for ~~work~~ but indefinite duration.

2a. CHRISTMAS BONUS: A Christmas Bonus will be paid to Italian civilians employed on a permanent or semi-permanent basis, such bonus to accrue at the rate of two days' pay per month, to be paid on the normal pay day before Christmas or at discharge, whichever shall occur first.

The attention of all units employing civilian labor is directed to the terms of Allied Force Headquarters Administrative Order No. 5 dated 6 March, 1946, which are republished hereunder.

1. General:

a. Following the established policy of flexible conditions of employment and terms of service for Allied Force employees in step with those prevailing in Italian Industry a Christmas Bonus, Dismissal Bonus and Paid Annual Leave will be granted to Italian civilian employees of the Allied Forces for each month of completed service or fraction thereof. (See paragraph 3b below). Furthermore, they will be granted six (6) paid holidays a year.

2a. CHRISTMAS BONUS: A Christmas Bonus will be paid to Italian civilians employed on a permanent or semi-permanent basis, such bonus to accrue at the rate of two days' pay per month, to be paid on the normal pay day before Christmas or at dismissal, whichever shall occur first.

1. General - Following the established policy of keeping conditions of employment and wage scales for Allied Force employees in step with those prevailing in Italian Industry, a Christmas Bonus will be paid Italian Civilian employees of the Allied Forces for Christmas 1945.

2. Eligibility and Rate - Italian civilian employees in the employ of the Allied Forces on 20 December 1945 are entitled to receive a Christmas Bonus.

The amount of the bonus for each employee will be two days' current basic pay and cost of living bonuses for each completed month of continuous service during the year of 1945 with the present employing unit or the predecessors thereof.

For the purpose of this computation all Italian Civilian employees in employ as of 20 December 1945 will be deemed to be continuing in employment for the balance of the month of December.

1. Much publicity has been given to the world shortage of foodstuffs and the recent restriction in the Field Service Ration Scale will have brought this shortage home to all ranks.

2. Special arrangements are made to provide a subsistence ration for the civilian populations of occupied and liberated countries. Military supplies diverted to feed civilian employees will necessarily reduce the overall availability of food stuffs to British consumers.

3. The object of GRO 1266 of 1945 is to limit this diversion of military supplies to the minimum essential for the efficient operation of the units and formations concerned.

4. Officers responsible for employing civilians will review their present commitments in the light of the GRO and of this letter. They will pay particular attention to the following points:-

- (i) Civilian personnel for whom rations are drawn are in fact eligible under para 4 of the GRO.
- (ii) Under no circumstances will the Field Service Ration Scale be drawn in this Command after 9 Dec 45 when the numbers exceed twenty in any one establishment (Para 8 of the GRO).
- (iii) When the number of entitled employees is twenty or less the FSR Scale will only be drawn if it is impossible to utilize the Italian Armed Forces Scale. It is pointed out that this is especially



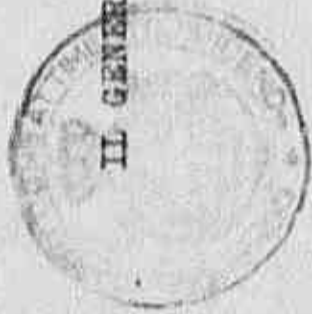
