1. It is considered that there are many personnel on the war establishment, and in some cases in addition to it, who are not fully employed. In other cases there are personnel on the establishment whom it is extremely unlikely to replace.

2. Unless the B.L.U. is to be kept at 100% W.E. which is extremely unlikely the effect of having large numbers of British Personnel as instructors, in many cases only partly employed, is to cause extra administrative work.

3. All heads of branches are therefore asked to submit by 0800 6th July to O.C. B.L.U. a list of their minimum requirements of training and administrative personnel required, giving details as to whether it is intended that they live centrally or out at schools.

4. On the basis of this it is proposed that D.A.A. & Q.M.G. studies requirements of administrative personnel required for H.Q. under two headings:

- (1) With administration and accommodation as on 5th July.
- (2) With all ranks of H.Q. accommodated at M.M.I.A.
