I have to report that, at ROME on the 16th. March 1946, about 0900 hrs, I was on "A" Emergency Duty accompanied by L/Cpl SCAPLEHORN A. C.M. Police, when I was instructed to proceed to the N.A.A.F.I. OFFICERS CLUB, PINCIO Gardens ROME, where a 15 CWT DODGE had been found abandoned.

On arriving at the OFFICERS CLUB I reported to 10670201 C.S.M. HOURS L. Warrant Officer i/c, who informed me the vehicle had been discovered outside the Club this morning and had presumably been there all night.

I inspected the vehicle and found it to be a 15 CWT DODGE W.D. N°409035 on charge to the Italian Driving School CIVITAVECCHIA.

I conveyed the vehicle to the Central Police Station ROME, where it was impounded.

We were proceeding along Via CAVOUR, in the direction of the CENTRAL RAILWAY STATION, when a BUROS 3 ton lorry WD No.45376764, was driven out of Via di S. MARIA MAGGIORE at a fast speed and without any warning was pulled straight across Via CAVOUR in the face of the main traffic.
