- 1.- Leave movement restrictions are placed for entry into a band 25 Kms wide on South of Italian Frontier and West of Morgan Line.
- 2.- As Imperia (San Remo) is outside of this band, it is sufficient for the Italian military to have their "foglio di licenza" and bilingual certificate proving validity of their documents.
- 3.- I believe that Distwo GSI/2226 of 7 Sep, of which this office has not retained a copy, states that as the approval of 13 Corps is necessary for Morgan line area so would approval of 7 AGRA be necessary for the French frontier sector within the 25 Km. band.
- 4.- MMIA A 020 of 17 July and A 020 of 15 Aug both copies to 2 District and F BLU refer to control of movement for leave, duty and demobilisation.

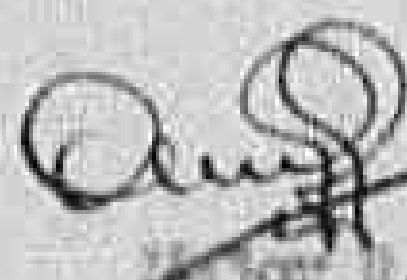

Ritengo mio dovere di informare oodesto "P" B.L.T.U. circa lo stato d'animo dei militari ex cooperatori e circa la possibilità del loro rendimento.

Tali militari che hanno fatto la guerra, passato un periodo di prigionia, che hanno poi lavorato con gli americani, sono lontani da molti anni dalle loro famiglie, hanno l'animo esasperato dal desiderio di ritornare, seppure per breve tempo, alle loro case.

Tale stato d'animo e poi scollato dal fatto che essi sono a conoscenza della circolare del Ministero della Guerra che stabilisce una licenza di sessanta giorni ai militari reduci dalla prigionia prima di essere impiegati nei reggimenti, e non comprendono perché si vuole negare a loro questo diritto e perciò si agitano ritenendosi ingiustamente maltrattati.

Io credo che su questi uomini stanchi, desiderosi di un poco di libertà, dopo molti anni di coesistenza, non si può fare nessun affidamento come soldati; anche se con la forza fossero portati ai gruppi di combattimento, senza che fosse concessa la licenza di giorni sessanta non avremo dei soldati, ma degli uomini agitati di cui potremo farne di nuovo dei prigionieri, ma soldati no.

Dopo la licenza che darà ristoro all'animo loro e adra una bonifica del loro spirito, quelli che torneranno potranno essere buoni soldati, anche perché avranno visto che le promesse delle autorità sono state mantenute.

Soggiungo che gli ex cooperatori appartenenti ai carabinieri, guardie di finanza, marina, aeronautica, che si trovavano a Livorno, da Livorno stesso sono stati mandati tutti in licenza di sessanta giorni.

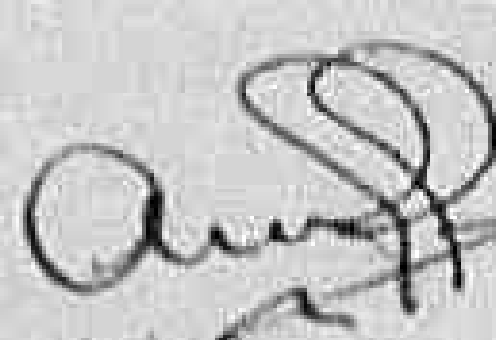

1. At present there appears to be a great difference between the various units at CESSAC as to the control of men going on leave to ROME. While some units check very carefully the number of men travelling by transport to ROME and their passes, other units will accept men on a truck if they have a pass or not.
2. The result is that while there is a check on the number of men going on leave with official passes there is none on unofficial (i.e., absence) leave.
3. If it was made a rule that the evening meal was a parade for the whole Centre and the names of men absent checked against the pass roll the number of men in ROME would diminish rapidly, and the crowd at PONTE MILVIO decrease. Alternatively the "fall-in" could be sounded at any time of the day at a time fixed by Comd., RHC ICP.
4. If men knew that this was going to happen they would be less keen on going into ROME without a pass.
5. It is, however, necessary to have a fixed rule for the camp as opposed to Regimental rules as at present.

1. AMM have given instructions for the following arrangements to be put into effect forthwith for the transportation of Italian Army personnel and Italian Co-operators on leave:-

(a) Rail wagons on freight trains will be provided under arrangements Movement H/Areas on a basis to be laid down weekly in the PM program. So far as practicable regular daily freight trains leaving starting points at the same time each day will be used.

(b) Tonnage allocation on the above basis will be included in PM programme by G-4 (Mov and Tr). Movements Liaison Officer MILA will submit the necessary details.

2. Where Italian POWs are available Italian leave personnel will report to them and they will arrange prompt and orderly embarkment. At stations where there is no Italian Movement staff this will be done by British or US POWs.

(a) Italian Army personnel will be in possession of Italian leave passes "Certificatos per VIAGGI in LUGGERIA" in the case of officers and "BILLET DE VIAGGE en LUGGERIA" for other ranks. In addition they will have a bilingual document certifying the validity of their travel documents.

(b) Italian Co-operators proceeding on duty as on leave will be in possession of movement orders issued by the Unit or formation or whose strength they are held. On the authority of these documents MILA will issue warrants which will be entered in Italian Movement under Allied Control covering the journeys to be made.

3. Italian personnel travelling on duty as individuals will also travel by the services outlined in para.1. Parties of 20 or more will move under arrangements Movement Areas or Sub Areas and capacity will be laid at the PM Conference by G-3 (Org) or G-4 (B) AMM.

4. Program of the bilingual document required as in para.2 (a) above is attached at Appendix 'A'.

1. Attached have been given instructions for the following arrangements to be put into effect forthwith for the transportation of Italian Army personnel and Italian Co-operators on leave:-

- (a) The various air freight facilities will be provided under arrangements Memoranda H/Aviation as a basis to be laid down weekly in the XII programme. So far as practicable regular daily freight trains leaving starting points at the same time each day will be used.
- (b) Passage allocation on the above basis will be included in XII programme by G-4 (Gen and En). Memoranda Liaison Officer MILA will submit the necessary details.
2. Where Italian EPOs are available Italian leave personnel will report to them and they will arrange passage and orderly environment. At stations where there is no Italian Memoranda staff this will be done by British or US EPOs.
- (a) Italian Army personnel will be in possession of Italian leave passes "Certificato per VIAGGIO in ITALIA" in the case of Officers and "FORMA DI VIAGGIO in ITALIA" for Other Ranks. In addition they will have a bilingual document certifying the validity of their travel documents.
- (b) Italian Co-operators proceeding on duty or on leave will be in possession of movement orders issued by the MIL or Variation on whose strength they are held. On the authority of these documents EPOs will issue warrants which will be entered "Italian Personnel under Allied Command" covering the journey to be made.
3. Italian personnel travelling on duty as individuals will also travel by the services outlined in para.1. Parties of 20 or over will move under arrangements Memoranda Avia or Sub Avia and capacity will be bid at the XII Conference by G-3(Reg) or G-4(3) AMB.
4. Prefares of the bilingual document required as in para.2 (a) above is attached at Appendix 'A'.

1. It is quite agreed that a relaxation of the percentage of personnel allowed on leave was permissible when the North was liberated, but it must be remembered that, in fact, the 15% now allowed on leave is made up as follows :-

5% Normal leave.
10% Extra for "Liberation" Leave.

2. It is not known how long the extra 10% will be permissible, but in any case only until all have had leave to their home in newly occupied territory.

3. The percentages allowed on leave always include personnel who fail to return from leave and who consequently are absent without leave.
