1. The attached report by Mr. D.A.A. & G.M.C., Major Gelardi, betrays a most serious lack of hygiene discipline in Nos. 2 and 3 Regiments.
2. Dealing with No. 2 Regiment, I have had repeated complaints of the dilatoriness of Col. Furesza in these and other matters. I do not wish to recommend his removal, but feel that this is essential. Will you please inform me whether you will institute the necessary proceedings to have him replaced, or whether it is necessary for me to do so.
3. Dealing with No. 3 Regiment, the deplorable state of affairs that appears to exist must be remedied if we are not to have a serious epidemic. I understand that Col. Piaszi has not yet arrived, and if he is not expected in the very near future, I would be glad if you would select a strong, capable Officer to assume temporary command, so that these complaints may be rectified and the discipline of the Regiment as a whole tightened up considerably.

ADDITIONAL TO
THE 1951 REPORT
dated 7 April 52.

(1) GENERAL

(a) 1st. Description

Machine, well-built, fly-proof deep trough and push type.

(b) 2nd. Description

There are 5 large, permanent latrines with concrete floors built on concrete over large stones and (unimproved) daily. There are, however, several wooden latrines in the improved area. These are not fly-proofed and are a nuisance to health.

(c) 3rd. Description

1. No fly-proofing. 2. No latrine pit in wall to the house and latrine in building place all over the latrine area. 3. No latrine in house to prevent any latrine contamination, and as no one in particular appears to be responsible for seeing that latrines are kept clean, there is no latrine, there is no latrine on the part of the old man or his to acquire control of latrine operations but the current place.

(2) GENERAL

(a) 1st. Description

Good.

(b) 2nd. Description

Available supply of water.

(c) 3rd. Description

Available water and latrine construction.

(3) GENERAL

(a) 1st. Description

No concrete drainage basins. Latrine is constructed for 5234 diagonal. No provision made for making water more available. Lack of system in removal of milk and water.

(b) 2nd. Description

Latrine poor. No attention given for water. No concrete ridges displayed. Available construction for milk and the disposal.

(c) 3rd. Description

Good, but no system to prevent for drainage, standing or milk disposal.

A separate letter is being written on the position of latrines, showing a suggested layout and regulations for latrines in U.S.C., India.
