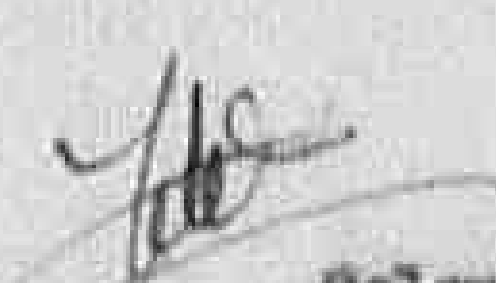

 - (b) The artillery have said they are satisfied with Bracciano therefore they have no complaint of being overcrowded.

5. There still appears to be doubt about the final lay out of Battalions, there are no signs showing headquarters or even what regiment is present.
6. There is no telephonic communication with GERMANY.
7. Although a visit had been notified the Commander was absent.
8. Officers report that many of the men are illiterate, though it was agreed that these men should be specially selected.
9. This interim infantry training is of the highest importance and the move and training of the Regiment concerned has the full support and interest of M.M.I.A. From a preliminary survey it would appear that the problem is not being tackled with enthusiasm or interest.

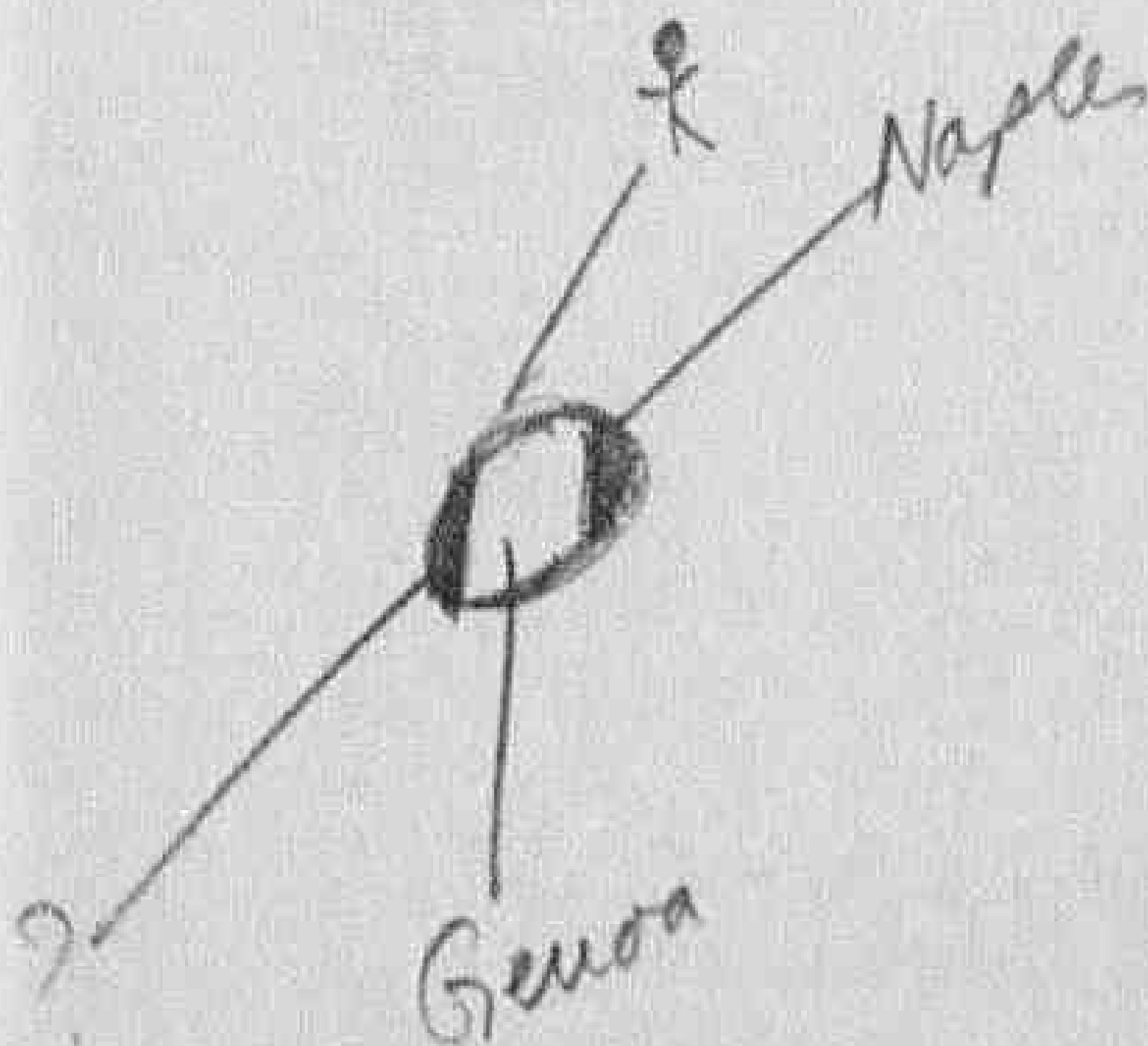

EXTRACT FROM HQ Movements Sub-Area, Rome, Mov 231/123 dated 18 July 45.

"2. Train A

Owing to the late arrangements made, it was not possible to place the stock in position until 2200 hrs 9 July for the move at 0700 hrs on the 10th. The Unit were told through 'F' BL and TU to load 75 tons G.1098 overnight.

When the RTO arrived at VITERBO at 0520 hrs, no loading had been done. He immediately ordered the loading of the baggage and the calling forward of the troops. The RTO's report states that there was very little co-operation from the Italian officer, the men were allowed to roam where they wanted and there was a complete lack of discipline.

In consequence the train left 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ hrs late and, on departing, the troops began to fire small arms into the air.

No representative of 'F' BLU and TU was present to assist and it appeared that the Unit had not been informed by them of the time of entrainment.

Strength entrained Officers 45, ORs 809, baggage 85 tons, stock 44 boxes.

3. Train B

5 box wagons were placed at 1200 hrs on 11 July for loading 75 tons baggage. Unit was ordered to load on 11 July, according to attached copy of M.I.

On arrival at VITERBO at 0430 hrs on 12 July the RTO found that little loading had taken place. In fact the stores were not delivered in any quantity until after 0700 hrs and the final loads were not tendered until 1030 hrs.

The RTO was unable to contact the Italian officers until 0730 hrs. No British Liaison Officers appeared throughout the whole entrainment. The CO of the Regiment came down at 0800 hrs, but was unable to give correct information until 1000 hrs, when the figures given were 32 officers, 352 ORs, against a scheduled 1000 all ranks. It appears that a large number had deserted.

In consequence the stock was cut down to 24 box cars. If correct information had been available previously, this would have saved the haul from ROME to VITERBO and return of 20 empty wagons. The train left VITERBO at 1045 hrs, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ hrs late.

Strength entrained Officers 32, ORs 352, baggage 80 tons, stock 24 boxes."

1. Reference your HAW/105/45(1st) dated 21 July 45, the following comments are made on the extract from H.Q. Movement Information Room letter, HAW/301/45 dated 18 July 45.

General Comments.

It is pointed out that it is not considered one of the functions of 1st British Division & Training Unit to supervise entraining and disentraining of Italian personnel. This is carried out entirely by the Italian under the supervision of the local R.I.C.

Train 4.

On the morning of 8 July 1945 information was received from Area Allied Command that the Garibaldi Regiment would be moving from Viterbo to Front in two separate moves, the first move to take place the following day. Initial movement time and details were received from R.I.C. and passed on to the Second-in-Command of the Garibaldi Regiment personally at 11.00 hrs. that day.

It was arranged with R.I.C. that the Movement Order would be collected from Movement Control Office at midday by 1st B.L. & T.O. on D.4. This was done and a translated copy of the Movement Order was sent by special R.I.C. to the Garibaldi Regiment at 14.30 hrs. the same day. (HAW/12/255 of 9 July 45, not to R.I.C.; refer).

In conversation with Movement Control, Staff Captain, 1st B.L. & T.O. raised the question of the R.I.C. arriving on board before the train departed, in case there should be any complications, and in reply it was stated by Movement Control that this was the best arrangement that could be made.

Train B.

After a series of orders and counter-orders it was ultimately confirmed by G.I. M.I.I. and Duty Officer R.I.C. at 13.30 hours 11 July that this move had to take place and that the train would be leaving the following morning.

General Comments.

It is pointed out that it is not considered one of the functions of the British Liaison & Training Unit to supervise entraining and detraining of Italian personnel. This is carried out entirely by the Italians under the supervision of the local R.I.C.

Train A.

On the morning of 8 July 1945 information was received from Area Allied Command that the Garibaldi Regiment would be moving from Victoria to Trent in two separate moves; the first move to take place the following day. Initial movement times and details were received from R.I.C. and passed on to the Second-in-Command of the Garibaldi Regiment personally at 11.00 hrs. that day.

It was arranged with R.I.C. that the Movement Order would be collected from Movement Control Office at midday by 1st B.I. & F. 3/4 on D.A. This was done and a translated copy of the Movement Order was sent by special D.A. to the Garibaldi Regiment at 14.30 hrs. the same day. (HQ/12/955 of 9 July 45, not to R.I.C., refers).

In conversation with Movement Control, Staff Captain, 1st B.I. & F. 3/4 raised the question of the R.I.C. arriving on hour before the train departed, in case there should be any complications, and in reply it was stated by Movement Control that this was the best arrangement that could be made.

Train B.

After a series of orders and counter-orders it was ultimately confirmed by G.I., M.I.I.C. and Duty Officer R.I.C. at 19.30 hours 11 July that this move had to take place and that the train would be leaving the following morning.

It will be appreciated that it was most to be expected for the Garibaldi Regiment to organize this departure at such a late hour. In fact, they did extremely well to get away as soon as they did.

D.A.A. & G.M.S. and Staff Captain 1st B.I. & F. 3/4 went to Victoria on the night of the 11 July and ensured themselves that the orders had been received by G.I., Garibaldi Regiment, and were present at a Movement Conference between Headquarters of the Garibaldi Regiment and Officers Commanding Garibaldi units.

The time of entrainment was given to be completed by 06.00 hrs. but it was fully appreciated that owing to the very late arrival of the orders to move it would be most improbable that this time would be adhered to. The Duty Officer at R.I.C. was informed of this fact by the R.I.C. at 12.00 hrs. 11 July, and the

night of 11 July, when it was foreseen that there would probably be a delay in the time of departure of this train. And a July 1945 P.L. 81.21.

was informed that the exact time of departure was not of great importance.

In regard to the fourth paragraph it is suggested that some information as to the matter to which was not available at this headquarters, although H.L.I.A. were informed that in the opinion of 1945 P.L. 81.21, departures would take place if the more length was ordered, the exact number of departures could not be foreseen, and it was not known until shortly before the train departed the number of men remaining to be transported.

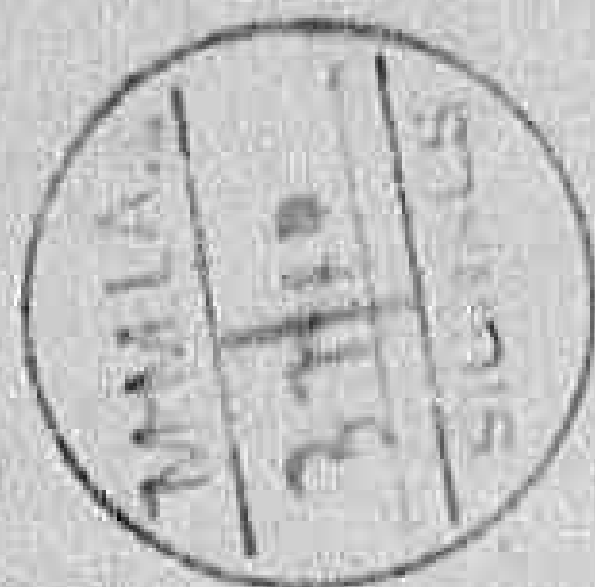

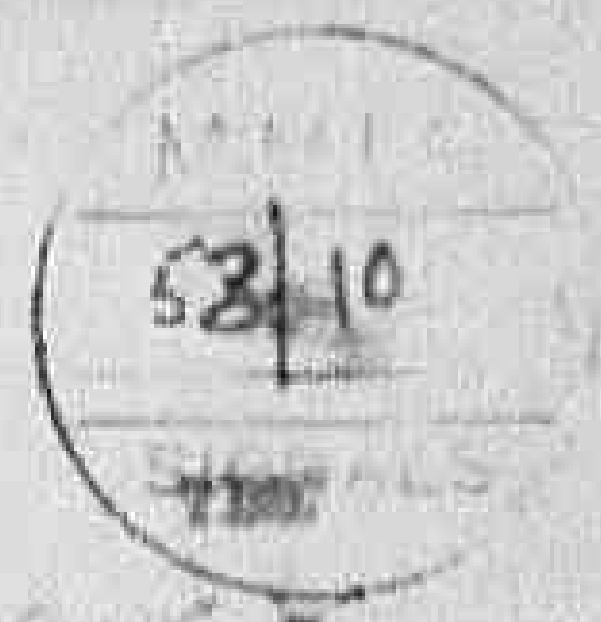

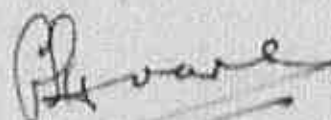
