

Reference R.A.A.C. letter IFC/AL/af dated 18 May 45, I have the following comments to make :-

Ref. para. 3.

The 31 vehicles in question are training vehicles from the D. & M. School. I inspected these, in company with the D.A.D.S.T., and B.L.R'd 19 and instructed that these vehicles be returned to 408 R.V.P. It was considered that the repairs to the remaining 12 could be done by the 152 Mechanical Engineering Platoon Workshop. It was not known, however, that 19 of their tradesmen would be demobilised on the 22 May 45. Anyway, when this loss of personnel was known, Captain Ferri was advised to submit (A.F.G. 1045's) Workshop indent to 638 L. of C. Workshops.

On 2 April 45 I submitted instructions to H.Q., RTC. ICF in my letter REME/MT/2/23, directing the control of cannibalisation. Unfortunately the instructions have not been passed on to O. i/c Workshops.

In defence of cannibalisation, the Workshops have found it necessary to cannibalise to keep vehicles on the road.

* The maltreatment of vehicles by Italians seems to be an inherent make-up of the race, and I am unable to offer a solution other than very severe disciplinary action for the slightest offence.

Priority of RTC ICF work is hardly to be expected from 638 L. of C. Workshops, but an easy solution to relieve the burden on the R.E.M.E. Workshops would be to have some suitable Italian Workshop sanctioned for the Centre. The British R.E.M.E. personnel here would be adequate to assist and give any help needed.

If tools could be supplied with the vehicles there would be no excuse for poor maintenance. Tools are needed badly. Maintenance has been foremost in our minds and a special washing and greasing Centre has been constructed and should be in use in a day or two, as you know.

1. Not your 0/86 dated 25 May 45.
2. The repair of vehicles situation at the R.P.S. I.C.C. Cetach was investigated by a R. M.R.C. Staff Officer of this Headquarters on 16 and 17 May 45.
3. It was found that 31 vehicles were lying at the repairing point of the Italian type L.C. attached there. Of these, 19 were found to be of Class 3 and below, in respect of which A/R 61043 were issued and instructions are being given for these vehicles to be returned to 408 R.T.P. The remaining 12 vehicles were found to be repairable and arrangements have been made for these to be accepted into 638 L of C Workshops Cetach.
4. It was definitely established that the reason for the unrepairability of the majority of vehicles was due to uncontrolled cannibalisation. Can steps be taken to ensure proper discipline as far as treatment of vehicles is concerned?
5. It is not possible to give priority over other units of this Command to the Italian Reinforcement Training Centre as far as repair facilities in L of C Workshops are concerned, although everything will be done to meet their requirements pari passu with British units.
6. It is understood that it is not possible to gain available additional workshop unit for the exclusive use of the Italian R.T.C. nor indeed should this be necessary.



1. The following is an extract from the monthly report submitted by Staff Officer, Royal Corps Signals in respect of G.M.C. Regiment:

"Transport."

"Use and maintenance of vehicles has passed under strict control, and has resulted in a steady decrease in the standards of maintenance and efficiency."

"It was found that instructions were being made of vehicles intended specifically for wireless training, G.O.C. Regiment had even sanctioned the removal of seats, valises etc. in these vehicles so that they might be used for transporting personnel and stores. In instruction was therefore given that wireless vehicles would be used only on the personnel authority of G.O.C. School. Within a few days however, a driver was observed leading the Parrotin with a wireless vehicle. He had apparently been sent for a vehicle by G.O.C. Regiment. School and had taken the first vehicle he saw. He was in possession of a "Foglio di Viaggio" issued by the Regiment but these clearly indicated vehicle for journey. The guard at the gate was unaware that the vehicle was not to be taken out. It is also observed that no check or examination of R.G.U. is entered on the "Foglio di Viaggio" and misuse of R.G.U. appears inevitable."

2. Will you please investigate this matter and inform this H.Q. what action has been taken to ensure that:

- (a) Proper care and maintenance of vehicles taken place;
- (b) No equipment is removed from any vehicle, nor any R.G.U. is on British vehicles and without authority of "Foglio di Viaggio";
- (c) G.O.C. issues and instructions is controlled and checked;
- (d) only drivers who have vehicles on display drive these vehicles;
- (e) Foglio di Viaggio are properly made out for a specific journey;
- (f) showing the number, make, etc., of the vehicle to be used and the name and title of the driver;

"Transport. Use and maintenance of vehicles has proved under most control, and has resulted in a steady decrease in the standard of maintenance and discipline."

It was found that instructions to use vans bedecked with vehicles intended specifically for wireless bearing, O.G. equipment and even contained the personal effects, vehicles etc. in these vehicles so that they might be used for transporting personnel and stores. In instructions was therefore given that wireless vehicles would be used only on the personal authority of O.C. School, V.M. In a few days however, a driver was stopped leaving the barracks with a wireless vehicle. He had apparently been sent for a vehicle by O.C. Artillery School and had taken the first vehicle he saw. He was in possession of a "ZEPPELIN" issued by the Regiment but there is scarcely room for vehicle nor journey. The guard at the gate was unaware that the vehicle was not to be taken out. It is also observed that no check of currency issued by P.G. is entered on the "veggio di viaggio" and misuse of P.G. appears inevitable."

2. Will you please investigate this matter and inform this H.Q. what action has been taken to ensure that:

- (a) proper care and maintenance of vehicles is maintained;
 - (b) No equipment is removed from any vehicle, nor any ~~VEHICLES~~ ^{VEHICLE} or British vehicles made without authority of ~~VEHICLES~~ ^{VEHICLE};
 - (c) P.O.L. issues and consumption is controlled and checked;
 - (d) only drivers who have permission to drive these vehicles!
- (a) Poglio di Viaggio are properly made out for a specific journey, showing the number, name, etc., of the vehicle to be used and the name and width of the driver;
 - (b) that Guards at Barracks entrances and exits are armed to check traffic di viaggio of all vehicles leaving the barracks.

1. On cause consideration of the tyres fitted to vehicles, it is evident that immediate steps should be taken to avoid.

- a) Vehicles being off the road, due to no tyres.
- b) Tyres being used until all the tread has been worn smooth and retreading impossible.

2. Tyres are a controlled store, and take time to be released and ultimately to receive.

3. The following provisional procedure will be adopted to divide responsibility in vehicles being off the road, due to lack of tyres.

- a) Units will report to 19 Port Battalion and obtain a Condemnation Certificate (A.P. C. 103) for tyres that the G.O. of the organisation thinks has a life of 200 miles or less. This will be stated on the condemnation certificate and allow a margin of 100 miles for reusing of new tyres, from the time of inspection.
- b) Units having obtained a condemnation certificate will credit it to an indent and credit it in the ordinary way G.O. 103.
- c) When the tyres are imported, so having been received by D.A.D.I.D., the tyres will be controlled by the unit up before fitting will be sent to the G.O. 19 Port Battalion, to ascertain whether the tyres to be replaced are to be changed immediately or replaced after a suitable wear. Requirements will be conducted under wartime supervision.
- d) The change of tyres will be noted in the A.P. 412 and A.P. 106, stating the No. of the tyres.
- e) Old tyres will be sent at minimum, and usually stores.
- f) If G.O. makes decision that the use of the tyres is not fit :-
 i. Tyres being run deflated.
 ii. Overinflated.
 iii. Cut or damaged deliberately.


