The particular round penetrated immediately outside the muzzle, the shell base ricocheting down the bore and coming to rest just above the chamber. The remainder of the fuse and shell splintered normally, making the usual eidentur pattern vertically below the muzzle. No useful pieces of shell or fuses were discovered.
- Firing in this detachment had not been good, but the low elevation (500 yards Ch II) were not such as to permit of "slipping back". There was no reason to suppose the driving band had not engaged.

One fragment was picked up 500 yards away, laterally.

No evidence of unconsumed filling in the fragments.



Brief Statement....An Airburst Shoot was in progress.

Guns were warm, having previously ranged with percussion (119) I/16704, was warm, having fired 3 HE119 and 2 HE223. The shell was not left in a hot chamber, as 3 rounds Salvo had been ordered. The round in question was the third. Fuse length ordered was 4.2, and all prepared rounds remaining were checked subsequently and found correct. The remaining fuses were firmly screwed home into the shell, the fuse length having been set from the rough length of 5.0. The particular fractured immediately outside the muzzle, the shell base ricocheting down the bore and coming to rest just above the chamber. The remainder of the fuse and shell splintered normally, making the usual airburst pattern vertically. No useful pieces of shell or fuse were discovered, but the search is being continued.

Training in this detachment had not been good, but the low elevation (3000 yards Ch. II) was not such as to permit of "slipping back". There was no reason to suppose the driving band had not engaged, for the ranging was not that bad.

Capt. (I.C.) L. Elgin Cullick R.A., was near the gun and witnessed the procedure.

Although nearly 200 more fuses and shells of the same or similar lots were subsequently fired from the remaining guns, no further procedures were experienced.
