1. In accordance with GRC 489/46 application by the above named Officer is submitted for leave to Switzerland on or about 5 Aug. 1946.
2. Since Captain Trevelyan has not had leave since 5 Dec. 1945, he is entitled to two periods of 7 days leave under the terms of GRC 493/46.
3. With reference to para 2c of GRC 489/46, it is stated by the British Consulate at Rome that a passport cannot be issued until authority for leave has been granted by the Commander in Chief, C.M.F. However it will be noted that under para 4b, Area Commanders are authorized to grant leave in accordance with the GRC.
3. Captain Trevelyan is willing to undertake the journey at his own risk and has made all necessary arrangements for his transportation, which will be either by rail or by civilian car. He is obtaining his currency requirements through banking channel via his home bank.
