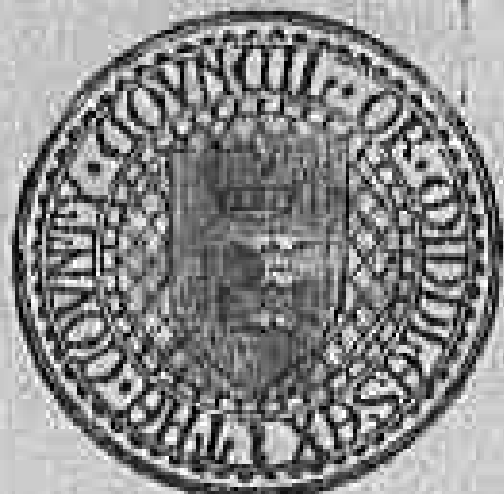

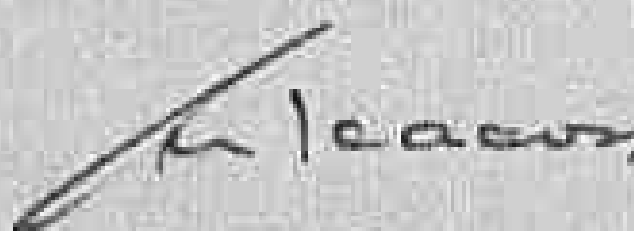

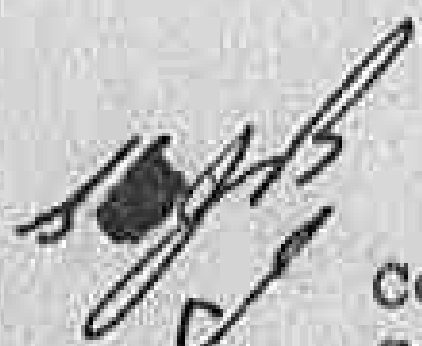

1. I have to thank you for your further letter regarding the above mentioned soldier, enclosing copy of a letter from the Italian woman with whom he is associating.
2. I have interviewed Cpl. Blackhurst and endeavoured to point out to him that he has specific responsibilities for the maintenance of his wife and child, and that he can in no way avoid them.
3. He appears adamant in his intention to refuse to return to his wife and is undoubtedly very enamoured of the Italian woman.
4. He is due for release in mid-July and will be returned to England for demobilisation. He appears to have no private means and I anticipate he will have considerable difficulty in obtaining the necessary authorities and funds to enable him to return to Italy.
5. This appears to be a case which is more likely to solve itself by allowing matters to take their normal course, rather than precipitating a crisis by attempting to interfere directly.
6. In view of the short period which remains before he is due for release, I do not think Higher Authority would contemplate a transfer to another theatre.
